SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR THE REVIEW OF "REQUEST FOR AMENDMENT TO
HFC-6000 SAFETY EVALUATION REPORT" (TAC NO. ME7577)

Dear Mr. Hsu:

By letter dated June 29, 2011 (Agencywide Documents Access and Management System Accession No. ML11199A098), HF Controls Corporation submitted for U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff review "Request for Amendment to HFC-6000 Safety Evaluation Report." The NRC staff has performed an acceptance review of "Request for Amendment to HFC-6000 Safety Evaluation Report" and found that the material presented provides the technical information in sufficient detail to enable the NRC staff to complete a detailed technical review.

We expect to issue our request for additional information by March 16, 2014, and our draft safety evaluation (SE) by January 20, 2015. This schedule information takes in consideration the NRC's current review priorities and available technical resources and may be subject to change. If modifications to these dates are deemed necessary, we will provide appropriate updates to this information. The review schedule milestones and estimated review costs were discussed and agreed upon in a January 3, 2014, email exchange between Mr. Ivan Chow of Doosan and Mr. Joseph Holonich of the NRC staff.

Section 170.21 of Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* requires that topical reports (TRs) are subject to fees based on the full cost of the review. You did not request a fee waiver; therefore, the NRC staff hours will be billed accordingly.

As with all TRs, the SE will be reviewed by the NRC's Office of the General Counsel (OGC) to determine whether it falls within the scope of the Congressional Review Act (CRA). During the course of this review, OGC considers whether any endorsement or acceptance of a TR by the NRC amounts to a rule as defined in the CRA. If this initial review concludes that the SE, with its accompanying TR, may be a rule, the NRC will forward the package to the Office of Management and Budget (OMB) for further review and consideration. Any review by OMB would impact the schedule for the final issuance of the SE.
