Ron,

The Class III UIC permit is part of the Permit to Mine since the state has primacy with the EPA. The first form (Form 1 –UIC) that accompanies the granting of Permit to Mine No. 778 is what is used as our application for the Class III permit. The state must also obtain concurrence with the EPA on getting an aquifer exemption as part of the Class III permit. This is attached. The other part of the Class III permit is notifying the state when Class III well construction is complete so that the wells can be used. This is also attached. Please let me know if you need anything else.
