Tom,

The Chinese regulator, China Atomic Energy Authority (CAEE) , received the applications from Sanmen and Haiyang Nuclear Power Plants, which stated that the transfer of 68 thermal dispersion switches from the U.S. to China would include both Unit 1 and Unit 2 for Sanmen and Haiyang. But the application (XCOM1253) you submitted on 4/29/2012 only mentioned Unit 2. CAEA, through the State Department, wanted to verify if ENERTECH would like to amend its license application to add Sanmen 1 and Haiyang 1.
