I have not personally toured the Diablo Power plant run by PG&E, however, I have been to numerous meetings where PG&E spokesmen has discussed the working of the plant and I personally know people who have gone on your tours and were very impressed by your careful handling and management of the spent fuel rods in dry cask storage and wet cask storage which they found very adequate.

Furthermore, I would like to see the Department of Energy take the responsibility to make good on its commitment to receive and safely store the spent fuel for the long term. By doing so, locally stored spent fuel could be safely removed to a single or regional locations controlled by and protected by our national government.
