PURPOSE: The NRC on November 25, 2013, published in the Federal Register (FR) a Conceptual Example of a Proposed Risk Management Regulatory Framework Policy Statement,” Pages 70354 – 70356 [FR DOC # 2013-28065] (ADAMS Accession No. ML13273A517) and requested public comment. An update was published on January 10, 2014, Pages 1898 – 1899 [FR DOC # 2014-00244] ADAMS Accession No. ML1354B810), that extended the public review and comment period to February 28, 2014, and announced a public meeting to be held on January 30, 2014. The purpose of the meeting is for the staff to answer questions, to provide any clarification to the white paper, and to solicit early stakeholder comments.
