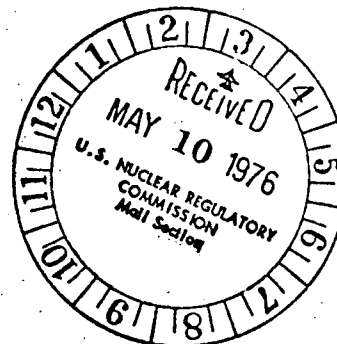
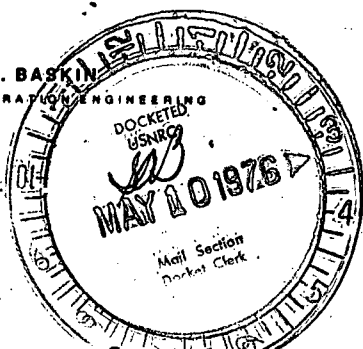

By letter dated April 12, 1976, additional information in response to the Commission's letter dated March 31, 1976, was submitted to the Regulatory Staff and served on all parties to the San Onofre Units 2 and 3 construction permit proceedings.

This letter forwards three sets of revised and additional information and errata corrections for the enclosures to our April 12, 1976 letter. Revised and additional information and errata corrections forwarded herewith include:

- (1) A revised Figure 2.1-2 of the NUS report, "Report of Tracer Tests Conducted at the San Onofre Nuclear Generating Station," which more precisely locates reference points for the sand disposal monitoring profile lines,
- (2) Revised pages A-1, A-6, and A-43 of Appendix A to the above referenced NUS report which provide errata corrections,
- (3) A revised Appendix B to the above referenced NUS report which provides standard deviation of wind direction for the lower elevation of the bluff tower and corrected maximum and minimum wind direction data,

- (4) A revised response to Item 6 which provides an update of observations of beach use within the reduced exclusion area,
- (5) Revised pages 7-1 and 7-2 of the response to Item 7 which reflect the confirmation of the data presented in Table 7.1 by letter and provides an update of observations of beach use in the vicinity of the reduced exclusion area,
- (6) A revised response to Item 8 which includes the information provided to Mr. R. W. Froelich of the Regulatory Staff on March 26, 1976,
- (7) A revised page 9-2 of the response to Item 9 which provides an errata correction,
- (8) A revised Figure 10-1 of the response to Item 10 which provides errata corrections, and
- (9) A revised response to Item 12 which includes a new Table 12-1 which provides the coordinates of reference points for the sand disposal monitoring profile lines.

Copies of this letter and the enclosure will be provided to the ASLB and all parties to the hearing in accordance with the attached Certificate of Service.

Additional copies of information forwarded by our April 12, 1976 letter, supplemented and corrected in accordance with the enclosures to this letter, will be provided by about May 10, 1976.
