This letter is in reply to your letter of December 29, 1977, to Mr. Jack B. Moore, Vice President, Southern California Edison Company.

At the present time, there are no additional ownership participants in San Onofre Units 2 and 3. The existing participants are Edison and San Diego Gas & Electric Company, with undivided 80% and 20% interests, respectively.

On November 1, 1977, Edison, San Diego and the Cities of Anaheim and Riverside entered into a letter agreement which contemplated acquisition, under certain conditions, by the Cities of Anaheim and Riverside of 1.66% and 1.79% interests in San Onofre Units 2 and 3. A copy of the letter agreement and related exhibits was attached to the Reply of Anaheim and Riverside to Memorandum Re Status of the Cities of Anaheim and Riverside dated January 5, 1978, which is on file in the above referenced docket.

I am sending a copy of your letter to Alan R. Watts, counsel for the Cities. I anticipate the Cities will prefer to submit the antitrust information directly to


