Thank you for your letter of October 3, 2013 in which you express the Nuclear Regulatory Commission's (NRC) position on the interest rate for the funding of long-term care for uranium milling facilities. We agree that the 2% interest rate for uranium milling facilities in our current regulations is incompatible with NRC regulations (Compatibility Category C). We propose to modify our regulations to address your comment as soon as is practicable. In addition, we will provide your office with a copy of the "as published" regulations for your review.
