Dear Madam Secretary,

The City Council takes its responsibility to represent and protect our citizens with utmost seriousness. At our Council meeting on December 3<sup>rd</sup>, we listened to several residents who expressed concerns about the Waste Confidence Draft Generic Environmental Impact Statement.

In accordance with the Nuclear Waste Policy Act of 1982, it is the responsibility of the federal government to secure permanent disposal for spent nuclear fuel. As this task has not yet been completed, the City of San Clemente wants to ensure the health and safety of its residents living in close proximity to the San Onofre Nuclear Generating Station (SONGS) until the spent nuclear fuel can be safely transported out of the area.

The San Clemente City Council respectfully requests your consideration of extending the public comment period for the Waste Confidence Draft Generic Environmental Impact Statement to February 28, 2014 to allow Council sufficient time to review the document. Thank you for your consideration.
