Global Nuclear Fuels-Americas, LLC (GNF-A) and Westinghouse Electric Company, LLC (WEC) requested a teleconference to discuss their future responses to first round requests for additional information (RAI) sent in a letter dated, January 16, 2014. WEC discussed each of the RAIs and their overall proposed responses. WEC indicated that they would add additional tables, calculation notes, and text to clarify confusions which resulted in the RAIs. As part of RAI-5, WEC indicated that the geometric and material k-effective effects would be factored as part of the modeling of package and package arrays as opposed to part of the overall k-effective effect from uncertainties. GNF-A will work with WEC and notify the NRC by February 7, 2014, as to whether or not an extension will be needed to provide a response.
