REQUIREMENTS

U.S. citizens entering or transiting Japan on official business must obtain a diplomatic or official visa for that purpose. U.S. citizens traveling with a valid U.S. passport can enter Japan for business or pleasure for up to 90 days without a visa.

All foreign nationals entering Japan, with the exemption of certain categories, are required to have their fingerprints scanned and a facial photograph taken at the port of entry. This requirement does not replace any existing visa or passport requirements. U.S. travelers on official business must have a diplomatic or official visa specifying the nature of travel as "AS DIPLOMAT," "AS OFFICIAL," or "IN TRANSIT" to be exempt from biometric collection. All other visa holders, including those with diplomatic and official visas stating "AS TEMPORARY VISITOR," are subject to this requirement. Passport type is also irrelevant. In rare instances, official travelers who bring a Note Verbale specifying they are entering Japan in an official capacity may be exempted from the biometric collection requirement, if otherwise required. SOFA personnel are exempt under SOFA Article 9 (2) from the new biometrics entry requirements.

SECURITY THREAT
INFORMATION

Please note that travelers to Japan should have a copy of their orders and official ID card with them at the time of entry. Also be advised that under no circumstances may weapons be brought into Japan. Carrying a pocket knife (including a Swiss army-style knife, craft or hunting knife, box cutter, etc.) in public is forbidden. Under Japanese law, carrying any such item in public, with a size exceeding 8 cm in length, 1.5 cm in width, and 2 mm in thickness can subject the person to arrest or detention.

U.S. Government facilities worldwide remain at a heightened state of alert. As the U.S. Government has reported in public announcements over the last several months, U.S. citizens and interests abroad may be at increased risk of terrorist actions from extremist groups, which may target civilians and include suicide operations. Americans should increase their security awareness and avoid locations where Americans are generally known to congregate. The Department will continue to develop information about potential threats to Americans overseas and to share credible threat information through its consular information program documents available on the internet at the Bureau of Consular Affairs homepage: <http://www.travel.state.gov>.

Threat Assessment: The events of September 11, 2001 serve as a reminder of the continuing threat from terrorists and extremist groups to Americans and American interests worldwide. This situation remains fluid and American citizens should be aware of the potential risks and take these into consideration when making travel plans. The Department maintains information about potential threats to Americans overseas, which is available to travelers on the Internet at the Bureau of Consular Affairs' homepage: <http://www.travel.state.gov/>. The Embassy takes all threats seriously. Embassy Tokyo can be contacted 24 hours a day at 03-3224-5000 (locally) or 81-3-3224-5000 (internationally).

The general threat from crime in Tokyo and throughout Japan is low; well below the U.S. national average. Violent crime is rare, but does exist. The Japanese National Police report continued problems with thefts and pick pocketing of foreigners in crowded shopping areas of Tokyo. Common sense security measures are advised for all American citizens traveling in Japan.

Visitors are urged to maintain a high level of vigilance and to increase their security awareness. Americans should maintain a low profile, vary routes and times for all required travel, and treat mail and packages from unfamiliar sources with suspicion. Visitors are also urged to avoid contact with any suspicious, unfamiliar objects, and to report the presence of such objects to local authorities. Vehicles should not be left unattended and should be kept locked at all times.

TDY ICASS POLICY

Tokyo's Policy for TDY Visitors Requesting ICASS Services

1. TDY visitors who request ICASS Services must bring or forward fiscal data to pay for any direct charges incurred during the visit, regardless of length of stay. Each agency, organization, or visiting delegation will be charged for the actual costs attributed to its visit. Examples of direct charges include, but are not limited to:

A. U.S. citizen and locally employed staff overtime;

B. Per diem and transportation costs for embassy employees in support of visitor's travel in Japan;

C. Commercially-leased vehicle at an estimated daily cost of about \$500 for sedan with driver; \$550 for van;

D. Cell phone rental and related charges at

an estimated daily cost of \$14 plus usage charge;

E. Interpreter services at a daily cost of \$1000 - \$1,200.

II. In addition to direct charges outlined above, TDYers who stay at post for more than seven days and who require ICASS services, will be charged for those services. A TDY invoice will be prepared based on the ICASS services to which a TDYer subscribes.

III. TDYers from an agency not present at post must be prepared to sign a Memorandum of Understanding and Subscription of Services Agreement for ICASS support services upon arrival. With the granting of country clearance, it is expected that the TDYer's agency will pay ICASS charges for services provided, will provide the appropriate agency ICASS billing code, and will authorize the TDYer to sign the ICASS invoice generated by the TDY module. (If you do not have an ICASS billing code, send a request to ICASSSERVICECENTER@State.gov.)

IV. In cases where travel is urgent, TDYers must bring the required documentation with them to ensure provision of services. Post will not provide any services to a TDYer staying in excess of seven days without provision of this documentation before day eight of the TDY.

NOTES:

1. The following categories of VIP visitors are not subject to ICASS TDYer invoice: the President, First Lady, Vice President and spouse, members of Congress, Supreme Court

Justices, and Cabinet members, including their related pre-advance and advance teams. For cabinet-level visitors, this exemption does not apply if the agency of the VIP visitor does not have a presence at post.

2. ICASS TDYer invoice will not be issued for TDYers who are:

- a) temporarily filling vacant positions or staffing gaps when ICASS services are already being billed for those positions;

- b) providing support for ICASS services;

- c) providing post-to-post assistance (TDYers sent from one post abroad to another to provide temporary support/assistance because the positions are charged for ICASS services at the "home" post);

- d) who do not require any ICASS services directly or indirectly.

3. For all TDYers without a sponsoring agency, all required services that are transaction-based, per capita-based, and space size-based will be captured on the ICASS TDYer invoice.

4. For all TDYers with a sponsoring agency at post, the transaction-based services are counted toward the agency's cumulative workload count, regardless of length of stay. Their ICASS TDYer invoice will capture only those services that are per capita-based and space size-based as appropriate.

5. Post will issue an ICASS TDYer invoice for a TDYer or a group of TDYers coming to post for a specific event based on a combined total of TDY days. If a group of 8 TDYers visiting post for the same event and each one of them stays 3 days of his/her choice, 17 TDY days will be subject to invoice calculation as charging starts on the 8th day. An eCC may not cover all TDYers in a group. However, the group's representative, who will sign the MOU and/or ICASS TDYer invoice as appropriate should be identified on eCC.

6. In accordance with the updated billing thresholds of seven days/\$500, an ICASS TDYer invoice will not be issued if the required

services do not cost \$500 or greater, when the service costs are counted, starting with the eighth day of TDY.

CURRENCY

Japanese Yen. Credit cards are widely accepted at most shops, restaurants and hotels. However, some credit card companies may charge an international transaction fee. Using Stateside credit cards for cash advances is limited and there are only a small number of ATMs that accept Stateside cards. Twenty-four hour currency exchange facilities are available in the customs area and arrival lobby of the airport.

Japan has the most advanced cellular industry in the world and BlackBerry protocols are not as advanced as what are being used in Japan today.

Before arrival (note the Embassy has notified the Japanese government of his visit and is working on his schedule.):

- The NRC is not issuing any media advisory or announcement of the visit.
- If asked, they will confirm on background and refer inquiries for further details to the Embassy.
- If pressed on the short duration of the trip, they will point out that the Chairman is testifying before the Senate Appropriations Committee on Wednesday.

Embassy is not issuing any announcement of his visit.

If asked, we will, on background:

- confirm his visit,
- note that he is visiting his team and Japanese officials to demonstrate at the highest level our continued support and close cooperation.

Monday's Schedule:

It is likely that the Chairman will encounter press (reporters & cameras) as he exits his meetings at either the NISA, TEPCO, the Prime Minister's Office, or the Cabinet.

There may also be a camera spray laid on at the top of one of the meetings [NRC/ECON – can you raise this question with our counterparts? We would not press for one but it is their prerogative.]

The Chairman would not speak to the press but rather the Embassy will release a statement in his name at the conclusion of his meetings [worth considering issuing that statement before the Cabinet meeting given the late hour].

Draft press statement elements:

- I traveled to Tokyo today to convey directly to our Japanese friends a message of support and cooperation, and to visit our team here to express my appreciation for all they are doing as we work together to resolve this crisis.
- Our nuclear experts are working side-by-side with their Japanese counterparts, and we continue to share scientific information as we move forward to resolve this challenge.
- We will continue to stand with the people of Japan as they overcome this tragedy, and we stand ready to continue to provide any assistance we can in the days to come.
- As President Obama said, we will stand with the people of Japan as they recover from this hardship and rebuild their great nation; the friendship and alliance between our two nations is unshakable.

App. 1517) requires Federal employees and their dependents, consultants, contractors, grantees, and others using United States Government financed foreign air travel to travel by U.S. flag air carriers unless a U.S. flag air carrier cannot provide the air transportation needed or use of U.S. flag air carrier service will not accomplish the NRC's mission.

On March 26, 2011 at the direction of the President, Chairman Jaczko was directed to fly immediately to Japan to support the NRC mission. Due to minimal lead time flight options were limited. Options for flights were reviewed and to the fullest extent possible American Carriers were selected. On the outbound flight the NRC travelers will fly American carriers to London, England and a foreign carrier the final leg. This will allow the NRC travelers to leave March 26 instead of March 27 and will increase the interaction time in Japan.

Based on the circumstances I am authorizing the use of a Foreign carrier on the outbound flight for Chairman Jaczko and Angela Coggins as necessary to accomplish agency mission.

Message for March 29, 2011

Here at the Embassy, we continue to work day and night to assess and understand the situation that started March 11 with the earthquake, tsunami, and the ongoing nuclear situation. I want to update you on what we have done over the last couple of days to address the situation.

As many of you know, our military and USAID teams continue to deliver thousands of tons of relief supplies and aid to areas along Japan's Northeast coastline that need it the most. We will continue these efforts as long as they are needed.

In Tokyo, we remain focused on the nuclear situation at the Fukushima reactor site and its potential effects with regard to radiation and food & water safety. Yesterday, the Chairman of the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission Greg Jaczko arrived in Tokyo. Chairman Jaczko's team has been on the ground working with us since the day after the earthquake and tsunami. And so yesterday's visit was a chance for him to assess the situation firsthand. Chairman Jaczko's visit was also an opportunity to demonstrate to the Japanese our commitment to support and assist them in any way they need in order to help understand and overcome the challenges they face. Together we visited with Japanese officials throughout the day for scientific and technical talks on how we can help.

Our team of doctors and public health professionals here at the Embassy from the Department of Health and Human Services, the National Institute of Health and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention continue to work around the clock to assess any possible health risks associated with radiation levels. They just met with senior Japanese government officials and health experts to analyze the situation and are advising me on a daily basis. In their discussions, they established task forces to focus on key areas for cooperation. They meet again tomorrow.

Like you, we are seeing reports about the high radiation levels close to the plant. We continue to monitor radiation levels in the air and in water outside the evacuation area and will share new information with you as we get it. The most recent measurements outside the evacuation area are within both US and Japanese acceptable levels. We anticipate there will be fluctuations in the levels from time to time. There are no changes to report tonight.

On our website, [japan.us embassy.gov](http://japan.usembassy.gov), we have posted video clips of experts from our government discussing issues you may find important to you such as radiation, potassium iodide, aftershocks, and stress management. My Twitter account is another way to get real time information about the situation. You can get a steady stream of information as well as communicate with me directly through my @AmbassadorRoos account.

This is a difficult time for all of us, but I want you to know that we are working hard to address the situation and to communicate to you what we know, when we know it.

Radiation Release From Japan Nuclear Facility Could Eclipse Official Sum

Thursday, Oct. 27, 2011

The quantity of radioactive cesium 137 that has escaped Japan's crippled Fukushima Daiichi atomic facility could exceed by more than twofold the level determined in an official calculation, specialists said in a report quoted by Bloomberg on Thursday (see [ISN](#), Oct. 27).

The six-reactor power plant was damaged by the March 11 earthquake and tsunami that left more than 20,000 people missing or dead in Japan. Radiation releases on a level not seen since the 1986 Chernobyl disaster forced the evacuation of about 80,000 residents from a 12-mile ring exclusion zone surrounding the site in Fukushima prefecture. Unlivable conditions could persist in the plant's vicinity for 20 years or longer, Tokyo indicated in August.

Measurements collected globally suggest the events resulted in the release of 35,800 terabecquerels of cesium into the environment, 42 percent of the amount to have escaped in the Chernobyl incident, U.S. and European experts said in a report published in *Atmospheric Chemistry and Physics*. The Japanese government in June said only 15,000 terabecquerels of the isotope, which breaks down at a rate of 50 percent every three decades, had moved out of the plant.

Roughly 20 percent of the cesium landed on Japanese territory, while air currents carried the other material out to sea, the document indicates (Tsuyoshi Inajima, [Bloomberg](#), Oct. 27).

The assessment suggests the disaster's effect on the Japanese capital was much smaller in scope than it might have been, *Nature* quoted one expert as saying.

"There was a period when quite a high concentration went over Tokyo, but it didn't rain," said Andreas Stohl, an atmospheric researcher at the Norwegian Institute for Air Research. "It could have been much worse" (Geoff Brumfiel, [Nature](#), Oct. 27).

No adjustments have been made to plant contaminant calculations issued by the Japanese Nuclear and Industrial Safety Agency and Tokyo Electric Power, the Fukushima site's operator. The quantity of contaminants moving out of the plant has fallen to one eight-millionth of the maximum level recorded in the crisis, the power company indicated last week.

Japanese Environment Minister Goshi Hosono in August said Tokyo would amend its computation.

"We don't need to add much to what was emitted in the early days," NISA atomic crisis official Yasuo Kosaku told Bloomberg. However, "the June estimate may have to be revised," he added.

Stohl said the expert assessment draws on a broader range of measurements than the Japanese government, which focused largely on information gathered within the country, *Nature* reported. The difference might help to explain the divergence in the two estimates, he said.

Personnel behind the government's figure "wanted to get something out quickly," said Stohl, who suggested their effort was understandable.

"Taking account of the radiation that has drifted out to the Pacific is essential for getting a real picture of the size and character of the accident," added Tomoya Yamauchi, a Kobe University radiation scientist who has been taking ground contamination readings in Fukushima prefecture.

The official and independent estimates are notably comparable when ambiguities in calculation procedures are taken into account, said Gunma University volcano specialist Yukio Hayakawa, who has also carried out computations related to the crisis (Brumfiel, *Nature*).

When the plant operator began firing water on the No. 4 reactor's spent fuel cooling pond as a temperature control measure, the release of cesium 137 "suddenly dropped," Bloomberg quoted the report's authors as saying. "This indicates that emissions were not only coming from the damaged reactor cores, but also from the spent fuel pool of unit 4," the document states (Inajima, Bloomberg).

The pond was apparently not harmed significantly, according to Japanese officials who discounted the area as a major cause of radioactive material emissions. "The release from unit 4 is not important," Masamichi Chino, a Japanese Atomic Energy Authority expert who aided in the preparation of the government calculation, said in remarks reported by *Nature*.

Still, the reading of the cooling pond's significance "looks convincing," said Lars-Erik De Geer, an atmospheric expert with the Swedish Defense Research Agency in Stockholm (Brumfiel, *Nature*).

Damage to the facility also led to the escape of 16.7 million terabecquerels of xenon 133, Bloomberg quoted the expert paper as saying. The radioactive isotope breaks down at a speed of 50 percent over 5.2 days and poses little threat, Tetsuo Ito, who heads the Atomic Energy Research Institute at Kinki University, said in a telephone discussion.

Separately, contaminants might have begun drifting from the site before the March 11 tsunami hit, 45 minutes following the earthquake, according to the report. "This early onset of emissions is interesting and may indicate some structural damage to the reactor units during the earthquake," it states.

The Japanese atomic agency stands by its view that the facility sustained no major harm during the earthquake, spokesman Tadashige Koitabashi said in a telephone interview. The official did not address the new assessment directly.

The tsunami compromised the plant's auxiliary power systems, halting its temperature mitigation mechanisms and prompting overheating in three reactors, according to the atomic agency and Tokyo Electric Power. Radioactive materials passed out of containment structures damaged by blasts at the facility (Inajima, Bloomberg).
