Dear Ms. Douglass:

On behalf of the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), I am informing you that the NRC is closing your July 5, 2013, appeal under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) as an administrative matter.

On May 7, 2013, you submitted a FOIA request (FOIA/PA-2013-0239) for a copy of 11 records. On June 10, 2013, the NRC provided a partial response to that request. On July 5, 2013, you submitted a letter to the FOIA/Privacy Act officer appealing the NRC's partial response. Subsequently, you filed a complaint in the U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia challenging the NRC's June 10, 2013, partial response and failure to provide three of the 11 records requested in your May 7, 2013, FOIA request. The NRC and Public Employees for Environmental Responsibility (PEER) entered into a settlement agreement in that case in November 2013. In December 2013, the NRC provided PEER with the final items due as part of that settlement agreement and informed PEER at that time that it considered all the terms and conditions of the settlement agreement to be satisfied. Consequently, the NRC is now closing your July 5, 2013, appeal as an administrative matter.
