Hi George and Tom,

The inventory of radioactivity listed in FSAR Table 2.1-2 (Bounding Values for Component Radionuclide Inventory) may need to be revised once AREVA completes its response to RAI 554, Question 11.02-27 and staff agrees with the revised contained source terms, which will be presented in FSAR Section 12.2 with representative values which may need to be updated in FSAR Table 2.1-2.

We won't know if Table 2.1-2 will need to be revised until the comparison is made with the values in the Chapter 2 table. This may be a non-issue if AREVA concludes that the values in for Component Radionuclide Inventory are still bounding.

Since this may impact Chapter 2. What are your thoughts on the ability to completely close Chapter 2 if we know that the Chapter 11 RAI response may affect FSAR Table 2.1-2?
