Paragraph 2.4.4 of the US Army Garrison Hawaii Radiation Safety Plan (RSP) for license number SUC-1593 (docket number 040-9083) says, "The License RSO will notify the NRC, by telephone or email within 30 days of a change in the Garrison RSO. The notification will include the name and contact information of the new Garrison RSO. The License RSO will follow up the rapid notification with formal notification by letter."
