Dear Sir:

Today, 11-28-72, a public hearing was held in Rm 1345, U.S. Court House, 312 No. Spring St., Los Angeles, Calif. concerning enlargement of the nuclear generating plant at San Onofre. I only learned of this meeting a few days ago and was unable to take time off from work to go. I am very unhappy about this because I know that the environmentalist bloc probably turned out in force. This country is on the brink of a disastrous power shortage. This means privation, unemployment, & suffering. The hardship resulting from inadequate electrical power is REAL and it is inevitable. People will die because they have lost their jobs and cannot afford medical care.

And yet the politicians continue to dance to the same old discredited ecology tune: the tune that says nuclear plants are doing enormous damage to the environment when in fact they are not.

I am just an average American - the forgotten man in this insane fiasco of self-destruction. I don't have any big organization like the Sierra Club to present my views at public hearings and to hire slick lawyers to set up road blocks to prevent projects from being carried out. All I can do is ask that this letter be included as part of the testimony and that my opinions be given as much credence

as the opinion of a person who happens to be a member of a special interest ecology group.

In any trial or hearing the burden of proof of an allegation should be upon the person making the allegation. I am sure that the Edison Company has presented ample evidence that the nuclear effects are nil, that the heat effects are nil, that the plants are safe, and that the power is desperately needed. I am also sure that the environmentalists will claim just the opposite.

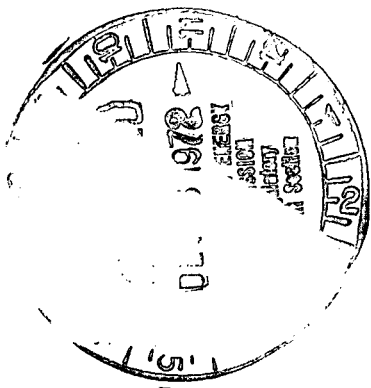
The tragedy is that no one from the general public was present to challenge the environmentalists and make them prove their claims. ~~They will~~ The burden of proof for these claims must be placed on the environmentalists. If they can not be proved (and proof is not some vague reference to some professor's opinion), then they are NOT TRUE.

I repeat: the vast majority of people in this state do not want to sit in a dark house with no electricity for washing clothes and cooking food. The vast majority do not want to swelter in a heat wave with no air conditioning because some jerk mistakingly thinks that a ^{water} temperature increase of 0.05°F might affect the love life of the California seaweed.

Perhaps ecologists have the right to be fools, but legislators do not.

Please let me know if this letter will be included as part of the testimony.
