This letter is in reference to the petition for rulemaking (PRM) dated February 18, 2014, which you filed electronically with the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC). Your PRM is available in the NRC's Agencywide Documents Access and Management System under Accession No. ML14071A382. You request that the NRC revise its regulations and to consider, in all pending and future reactor licensing and re-licensing decisions, new and significant information bearing on the environmental impacts of high-density spent fuel storage in reactor pools and the costs and benefits for avoiding or mitigating those impacts. The NRC docketed your petition pursuant to § 2.802 of Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (10 CFR), "Petition for rulemaking," on March 12, 2014, and assigned it Docket Number PRM-51-31.
