This letter is to request amendment of Radioactive Materials License GA-832-1G. The requested amendment would remove 'Industrial Automation and Control' from the Licensee name, which would become simply Honeywell Inc. A check in the amount of \$380.00 has been included to cover the cost of the amendment.

The reason for this request is that Honeywell Inc. has made some marketing-oriented organizational changes resulting in dropping the IAC portion of our name and substituting Global Products and Systems. In order to eliminate the need to request a future amendment if this new group name changes, it was decided to simply use the name Honeywell Inc. as the Licensee name. There are no other changes in the radiation safety program or reporting structure, this is solely a name change.
