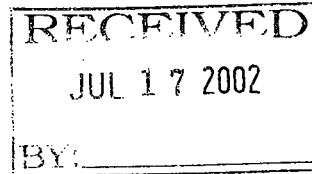

As mentioned in Honeywell's letter dated November 30, 2001, Honeywell Inc was scheduled to be merged into Honeywell International Inc. effective December 31, 2001. After numerous delays, the merger has finally been completed. The last amendment for license GA-832-1G, Amendment 36, already recognizes the new name.

We are requesting that the active SS&D registration sheets issued to Honeywell Inc. also be amended to reflect the name change to Honeywell International Inc. We are also requesting that the manufacturer for the SS&D registration sheets be amended. The new name and address is:
