

The purpose of this modification is to:

- 1) update the price schedule to match the rates incorporated in Modification No. 0010 of the base Blanket Purchase Agreement.
- 2) decrease the overall task order ceiling by \$5,452.80 to adjust for the savings related to the lower rates.
- 3) exercise option year 2 of this task order therefore increasing the current exercised ceiling by \$698,082.80 from \$1,006,037.32 to \$1,704,120.12 and extending the current period of performance through 2/28/2015.
- 4) increase the obligated amount by \$102,000 from \$320,000 to \$422,000.

2. Section A.2 of the task order entitled consideration and obligation is modified to read as follows:

A.2 NRCB050 CONSIDERATION AND OBLIGATION-TASK ORDERS

- a. The ceiling of this order for services is \$1,704,120.12.
- b. This order is subject to the minimum and maximum ordering requirements set forth in the contract.
- c. The amount presently obligated with respect to this order is \$422,000. The obligated amount shall, at no time, exceed the order ceiling as specified in paragraph (a) above. When and if the amount(s) paid and payable to the Contractor hereunder shall equal the obligated amount, the Contractor shall not be obligated to continue performance of the work unless and until the Contracting Officer shall increase the amount obligated with respect to this order, in accordance with FAR Part 43 - Modifications. Any work undertaken by the Contractor in excess of the obligated amount specified above is done so at the Contractor's sole risk and may not be reimbursed by the Government.
- d. The Contractor shall comply with the provisions of FAR 52.232-22 - Limitation of Funds, for incrementally-funded delivery orders or task orders.

- 3) Section A.13 is hereby added to the task order:

- b. Performance of the work under this contract is subject to the technical direction of the NRC project officer. The term technical direction is defined to include the following:
 1. Technical direction to the contractor which shifts work emphasis between areas of work or tasks, authorizes travel which was unanticipated in the Schedule (i.e., travel not contemplated in the Statement of Work or changes to specific travel identified in the Statement of Work), fills in details, or otherwise serves to accomplish the contractual statement of work.
 2. Provide advice and guidance to the contractor in the preparation of drawings,

specifications, or technical portions of the work description.

3. Review and, where required by the contract, approve technical reports, drawings, specifications, and technical information to be delivered by the contractor to the Government under the contract.
- c. Technical direction must be within the general statement of work stated in the contract. The project officer does not have the authority to and may not issue any technical direction which:
 1. Constitutes an assignment of work outside the general scope of the contract.
 2. Constitutes a change as defined in the "Changes" clause of this contract.
 3. In any way causes an increase or decrease in the total estimated contract cost, the fixed fee, if any, or the time required for contract performance.
 4. Changes any of the expressed terms, conditions, or specifications of the contract
 5. Terminates the contract, settles any claim or dispute arising under the contract, or issues any unilateral directive whatever.
- d. All technical directions must be issued in writing by the project officer or must be confirmed by the project officer in writing within ten (10) working days after verbal issuance. A copy of the written direction must be furnished to the contracting officer. A copy of NRC Form 445, Request for Approval of Official Foreign Travel, which has received final approval from the NRC must be furnished to the contracting officer.
- e. The contractor shall proceed promptly with the performance of technical directions duly issued by the project officer in the manner prescribed by this clause and within the project officer's authority under the provisions of this clause.
- f. If, in the opinion of the contractor, any instruction or direction issued by the project officer is within one of the categories defined in paragraph (c) of this section, the contractor may not proceed but shall notify the contracting officer in writing within five (5) working days after the receipt of any instruction or direction and shall request that contracting officer to modify the contract accordingly. Upon receiving the notification from the contractor, the contracting officer shall issue an appropriate contract modification or advise the contractor in writing that, in the contracting officer's opinion, the technical direction is within the scope of this article and does not constitute a change under the "Changes" clause.
- g. Any unauthorized commitment or direction issued by the project officer may result in an unnecessary delay in the contractor's performance and may even result in the contractor expending funds for unallowable costs under the contract.
- h. A failure of the parties to agree upon the nature of the instruction or direction or upon the contract action to be taken with respect to the instruction or direction is subject to 52.233-1 - Disputes.

- i. In addition to providing technical direction as defined in paragraph (b) of the section, the project officer shall:
 - 1. Monitor the contractor's technical progress, including surveillance and assessment of performance, and recommend to the contracting officer changes in requirements.
 - 2. Assist the contractor in the resolution of technical problems encountered during performance.
 - 3. Review all costs requested for reimbursement by the contractor and submit to the contracting officer recommendations for approval, disapproval, or suspension of payment for supplies and services required under this contract.

All other terms and conditions remain unchanged.
