Dear Ms. Sanders:

This letter acknowledges receipt of your memo dated July 1, 2005 enclosing an invoice for a radioactive material license annual fee. Pursuant to our correspondence with Mr. Jameson of your office, this annual license renewal was placed on hold pending a decision regarding transferring the license to Sodern's office in the US, which has taken over the supply and service of the CNA (Continuous Neutron Analyzer) for which the neutron tubes supplied by Sodern are used. Polysius no longer sells or services the CNA. Polysius had requested to terminate the license in accordance with Chapter 391-3-17.02(18), however, that request was amended to request a transfer of the license to Sodern. A copy of correspondence from 2004 regarding this matter is enclosed for your reference.
