Dear Mr. Jameson:

This letter acknowledges your inspection meeting on July 2, 2004 with Mark Mueller at our office. In accordance with Chapter 391-3-17.02(18), please find enclosed a "Request to Terminate Radioactive Material License" on behalf of Polysius Corp., formerly known as Krupp Polysius. This Request to Terminate is filed because since mid-2003, Polysius no longer sells or services the CNA (Continuous Neutron Analyzer) for which the neutron tubes supplied by a sub-vendor, Sodern, are used. It is our understanding that Sodern's office in the US will take over the supply and service of these items.

Since the license was issued in 1999, Polysius has sold the Sodern tubes on only two occasions to customers in Florida for use in a CNA in a cement production facility, neither of which involved the presence of source material in the State of Georgia. In 1999, Sodern tubes were delivered directly to Florida Rock Industries in Newberry, FL (as detailed in Polysius' license application dated June 3, 1999) and in 2003, Sodern tubes were delivered directly to Suwannee American Cement Co., Inc. in Branford, FL. In accordance with Chapter 391-3-17.02(19), Polysius verified that both customers were properly licensed by the State of Florida. Relevant documentation concerning the end users is enclosed for your information. Accordingly, the enclosed request certifies that the transfers to these two customers have properly disposed all licensed material. Because no licensed activities were carried out in Georgia, a radiation survey is not required.

Thank you for your consideration of the enclosed request to terminate Polysius' license. We look forward to receiving your confirmation of the termination of the license. Please do not hesitate to contact me if you have any questions.
