Good afternoon,

Thanks for checking with us for the KI order.

8000,000 tablets of the 65 mg (400,000 adult doses) will be sufficient to replace the 2014 stocks.

That will leave us with approx. 1,100,000 doses of 2015 KI for replacement next year.

This does account for the closure of the CR plant, but the entire population EPZ for that plant is very small, and the increase in the SL and TP population numbers more than accounted for the loss of CR.
