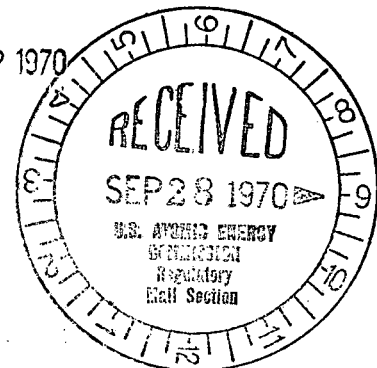

Dear Mr. Price:

We have reviewed the Environmental Statement from the Southern California Edison Company and San Diego Gas and Electric Company for the San Onofre Nuclear Generating Stations Units 2 and 3, as requested by your letter of August 18, 1970.

The following comments are provided:

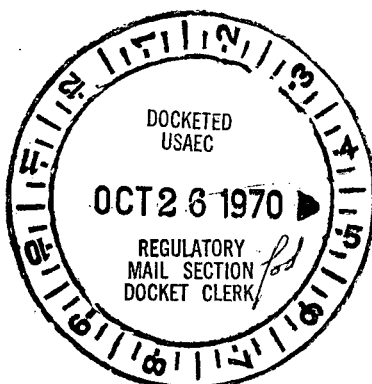
1. Insufficient information is presented within the Statement to permit evaluation of environmental impact. Estimated radioactive releases and exposures during normal operations and accident conditions should be presented and related to the AEC limits of 10 CFR 20 and 10 CFR 100. These estimates should consider the combined operation of all three units at the San Onofre Site.

2. Detailed information regarding the environmental monitoring program is not contained within the Statement. The specification of sample types as well as their frequency and location should be included within the Environmental Statement.
