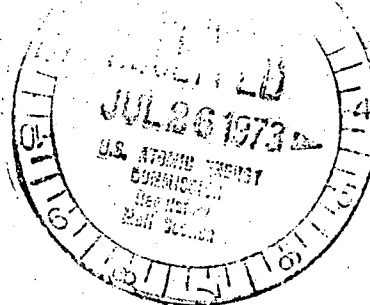

Dear Sirs:

The San Diego Region of the California Coastal Zone Conservation Commission will be holding a public hearing to help the Commissioners in assessing the environmental impact of San Onofre Nuclear Units #2 and #3. Before the San Onofre Units can be constructed, the San Diego Coast Regional Commission must make a finding that no substantial advanced environmental impacts will be caused by the project. The hearing will be held on Friday, August 10th, in Room B-109 of the State Building, at 1350 Front Street, San Diego.

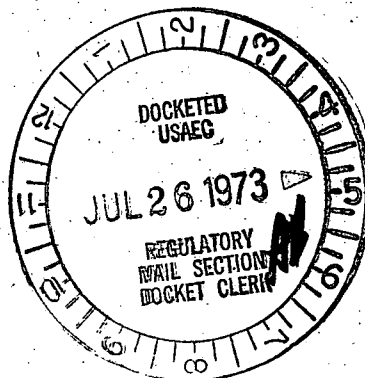
