### **INSTITUTE ELECTS CHAIRMAN, VICE CHAIRMAN, DIRECTORS, AND OFFICERS**

Today, the Board of Directors of the Institute of Nuclear Power Operations (INPO) re-elected Thomas F. Farrell II as chairman of the Board. Farrell is chairman, president, and chief executive officer of Dominion. The INPO Board also elected as vice chairman Christopher M. Crane, president and chief executive officer, Exelon Corporation.

Elected as new members of the Board of Directors were Dennis L. Koehl, president and chief executive officer of STP Nuclear Operating Company and Kevin B. Marsh, chairman and chief executive officer of SCANA Corporation.

Koehl assumed his current position in 2012. STP operates the South Texas Project Electric Generating Station near Wadsworth, TX. Prior to joining STP, he was senior vice president and chief nuclear officer for Xcel Energy, responsible for activities at Prairie Island and Monticello nuclear plants. Koehl joined Nuclear Management Company in 2004 as site vice president of Point Beach nuclear plant. He has more than 30 years of experience in the nuclear industry, including positions of increasing responsibility at Tennessee Valley Authority's Sequoyah and Watts Bar nuclear plants. He is also chairman of the Nuclear Energy Institute's Nuclear Strategic Issues Advisory Committee and serves on the 12-member U.S. Fukushima Response Steering Committee and is an executive member of the Electric Power Research Institute's Nuclear Power Council. He earned his bachelor of science degree in mechanical engineering from the U.S. Naval Academy and served in the U.S. Navy aboard the U.S.S. Patrick Henry nuclear-powered submarine.

Marsh joined South Carolina Electric & Gas Company (SCE&G), the principal subsidiary of SCANA Corporation in 1984. SCE&G and Santee Cooper, a state-owned utility in South Carolina, are currently building two 1,117-megawatt nuclear electric-generating units at V. C. Summer Nuclear Station in Fairfield County, SC, where V. C. Summer Unit 1 has been in commercial operation for more than 30 years. Marsh became a vice president at SCE&G in 1989 and in 1996 was named vice president and chief financial officer (CFO) of SCANA and became senior vice president in 1998. In addition to his duties as SCANA's CFO, from October 2001 to March 2003 he served as president and chief operating officer (COO) of PSNC Energy, the company's natural gas distribution company. He became president of SCE&G in 2006 and was named president and COO of SCANA Corporation in January 2011. He assumed responsibilities as chairman and CEO in December 2011. Prior to his career at SCANA, he worked at Deloitte & Touche Certified Public Accountants. He earned a bachelor of business administration degree in accounting from the University of Georgia.
