The 2,000,000 doses of 65 mg KI is 625 cases, 3200 doses/case.  
Here are the cases/county breakdown with rounding up to the nearest case:  
Wayne: 25 cases  
Orange: 7 cases  
Westchester: 204 cases  
Oswego: 79 cases  
Putnam: 16 cases  
Monroe: 54 cases  
Rockland: 157 cases

That would leave 83 cases being shipped to NYS.
