14 tell from the email?

15 JEFF KOWALCZIK: Department of State.

16 NANCY FRAGOYANNIS: Oh, she is from State
17 Department. Okay, because what we were thinking about
18 doing and following up, apparently someone from DHS was
19 going to come in at 4 o'clock this morning and hopefully,
20 and they would get a --

21 JEFF KOWALCZIK: Going to the NRC Op Center?

22 NANCY FRAGOYANNIS: No, from what I can tell
23 is that this email coming from Prea says he will be joining
24 the Task Force, I guess at State Department, at 4 o'clock.

25 JEFF KOWALCZIK: Oh, okay. Okay, I got you.

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1 NANCY FRAGOYANNIS: And then they were going
2 to follow up with them to know if he knows anything further
3 about the request that they put in the NOC and then we'll
4 call them up after 4 o'clock and find out if they know
5 anything --

6 JEFF KOWALCZIK: Okay, (inaudible).

7 NANCY FRAGOYANNIS: I mean, because you
8 don't really -- I'm sorry.

9 JEFF KOWALCZIK: I was just, you know, to
10 give you the background of where this came from.

11 NANCY FRAGOYANNIS: Okay.

12 JEFF KOWALCZIK: Is when this came out, let's
13 see, must have been -- trying to see when they sent it
14 to me. They forwarded me, let's see, 7:43. Yes, they
15 forwarded it to me several hours late.

16 But there was just a question about if we
17 had heard anything from interagency on the request for
18 that number one and the answer, of course, is no and,
19 you know, we said who is this because, you know, the
20 logical thought was that that came through the Department
21 of State.

22 And they said, no, we hadn't heard anything
23 either, just for clearance. It just sounds like it was
24 what we had offered, not really had been requested because
25 they really hadn't requested anything yet. It was just

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1 stuff we were doing and that's pretty much the feeling
2 they got for all, what is it, six things that they had
3 requested.

4 NANCY FRAGOYANNIS: Yes, four, five six.
5 Yes, it looks like six, yes. Okay. I guess when they
6 went through it on the ET they wanted one of us to follow
7 up on it here so I was just going to wait and call State
8 after that 4 o'clock --

9 JEFF KOWALCZIK: Okay, sure.

10 NANCY FRAGOYANNIS: -- and then get feedback
11 and then I'll let you know what I hear from them because
12 --

13 JEFF KOWALCZIK: Sure. If you need a contact
14 number for Prea, I can give you that. I can see if I
15 --

16 NANCY FRAGOYANNIS: Oh, please. I'll take
17 that number. That'd be great.

18 JEFF KOWALCZIK: Well, I don't have it right
19 now. I'll call you back with one or I could email it
20 to you. It's up to you.

21 NANCY FRAGOYANNIS: Okay, give me an email.
22 I'm at lia03.

23 JEFF KOWALCZIK: Okay, 03?

24 NANCY FRAGOYANNIS: 03.

8 JEFF KOWALCZIK: Hey, were you the one
9 wanting Prea's (phonetic) number to talk to at the Task
10 Force for Department of State?

11 NANCY FRAGOYANNIS: Yes, yes.

12 JEFF KOWALCZIK: Okay. We're going through
13 herfortwothingsandI'mjusttryingtomakesureeverybody
14 -- I think there was, I got an email from, let me see,
15 she sent me an email back saying she was talking to the
16 NRC International Liaison.

17 NANCY FRAGOYANNIS: That's either Eric
18 (phonetic) or me, yes.

19 JEFF KOWALCZIK: Right, okay, okay. So I
20 don't know if you talked to her or Eric did.

21 NANCY FRAGOYANNIS: No, on what topic?

22 JEFF KOWALCZIK: The coordination of the
23 meeting with --

24 NANCY FRAGOYANNIS: UK?

25 JEFF KOWALCZIK: UK.

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1 NANCY FRAGOYANNIS: Yes, Eric had spoken
2 with her.

3 JEFF KOWALCZIK: Okay. Okay, great.

4 NANCY FRAGOYANNIS: And that's arranged,
5 yes.

6 JEFF KOWALCZIK: Okay, yes, and she knew
7 about that but she also -- we were also going to try
8 to run down I know the NOC request or the (inaudible)
9 in the NOC report. I've got a number for you. She just
10 got back with me with her phone number if you'd like
11 to call her --

12 NANCY FRAGOYANNIS: Oh, that'd be great.

13 JEFF KOWALCZIK: -- and see if their DHS
14 coordination person is there yet.

15 NANCY FRAGOYANNIS: Great.

16 JEFF KOWALCZIK: Her number is 202-647-6611.

17 NANCY FRAGOYANNIS: Okay, 647-6611.

18 JEFF KOWALCZIK: Yes, ma'am.

19 NANCY FRAGOYANNIS: Okay.

20 JEFF KOWALCZIK: She is probably, want to
21 say expecting your call but I haven't heard any news
22 as of yet regarding us being out of the loop or included
23 even in the loop on that NOC report. I just think that
24 language is bad in there but you're welcome to kind of
25 close that loop with her if she's got any additional

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1 info.

2 NANCY FRAGOYANNIS: That would be great.
3 Yes, that's all I want to do because if a DHS rep comes
4 in there and she talks to them and then they can say,
5 well, it was written incorrectly, well, fine. We just
6 wanted to make sure. They just want us to follow up
7 on it, close the loop.

8 JEFF KOWALCZIK: Okay. Is Tom Blount
9 available?

10 NANCY FRAGOYANNIS: Yes, he's just standing
11 right here.

12 JEFF KOWALCZIK: All right.

13 NANCY FRAGOYANNIS: Do you want to talk to
14 him?

15 JEFF KOWALCZIK: Yes, please.

16 NANCY FRAGOYANNIS: Sure, hold on. I'm
17 kidding. He's actually working really hard. Let me get
18 him away from his desk.

19 JEFF KOWALCZIK: Okay.

20 NANCY FRAGOYANNIS: Hold on.

21 TOM BLOUNT: Hi, Joe (phonetic).

22 JEFF KOWALCZIK: Hey, Tom. How are you,
23 sir?

24 TOM BLOUNT: I'm good.

25 JEFF KOWALCZIK: Good, good. Hey, either

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1 me or Mike Dudek, whoever's here at 7:30 this morning,
2 has to brief the USAID administrator on our chunk of
3 the puzzle here so I want to --

4 TOM BLOUNT: We'll get you a copy of the
5 status update report.

6 JEFF KOWALCZIK: Sure. I want to make sure
7 that the feeling is in there because the status, you
8 know, I'm reading the status and I'm hearing what's done,
9 you know, what Chris Miller just described over at the
10 interagency call and they kind of have different feelings.

11 And I just want to make that that was, you
12 know, in addition to whatever the status update is, maybe
13 I'll touch base to you guys around 7 o'clock or something
14 like that and just, you know, and any of these things
15 that we, you know, this will be a personal brief so in
16 any of these briefs there's probably a little flavor
17 to them. You know, is it going up or is it going, you
18 know, as far as (indiscernible, possibly turning up,
19 turning down). I don't want to send the wrong message
20 unintentionally because of a couple word choices based
21 off of a status report, so --

22 TOM BLOUNT: And what time is that brief?

23 JEFF KOWALCZIK: 7:30.

24 TOM BLOUNT: Okay.

25 JEFF KOWALCZIK: So, I mean, I know you guys

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1 are changing shifts right before that. I will be also
2 but, like I said, I just kind of want to touch base with
3 somebody so I will probably be calling back around the
4 same time you guys send a status report, whatever time
5 that is this morning.

6 TOM BLOUNT: Actually we're putting the
7 status report together right now and we're probably about
8 15 minutes behind but we'll --

9 JEFF KOWALCZIK: No. I don't need it.
10 (Indiscernible, possibly I don't know if there's another
11 one that comes around 7 o'clock. I'll probably brief
12 on that.)

13 TOM BLOUNT: No, the next one's not due for
14 another 12 hours.

15 JEFF KOWALCZIK: Okay. Okay, no problem.
16 (Indiscernible, possibly I'll just go off of this one.)

17 TOM BLOUNT: Yes, this'll be the latest and
18 greatest and I believe our folks on the ground are
19 (inaudible) get some sleep here shortly so I'm not
20 expecting a whole lot of substantive changes.

21 JEFF KOWALCZIK: Okay.

22 TOM BLOUNT: Not unless the world ends.

23 JEFF KOWALCZIK: (Inaudible) I guess.
24 Okay.

25 TOM BLOUNT: All right?

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1 JEFF KOWALCZIK: That's all I needed. Thank
2 you, sir.

3 TOM BLOUNT: You bet.

4 JEFF KOWALCZIK: All right, appreciate it.

5 TOM BLOUNT: Bye-bye.

can I help you?

NANCY FRAGOYANNIS: Hi, is Prea (phonetic)
in, please?

FEMALE PARTICIPANT: Hold on one second.

NANCY FRAGOYANNIS: Thank you.

PREA: This is Prea.

NANCY FRAGOYANNIS: Hi, Prea. This is Nancy
Fragoyannis from the Nuclear Regulatory Commission.

PREA: Hi.

NANCY FRAGOYANNIS: How are you?

PREA: Good, thanks.

NANCY FRAGOYANNIS: I was reading this email
that you had sent to Jeff Kowalczyk, God, when was it,
1:24 a.m., regarding the NOC report.

PREA: Yes.

NANCY FRAGOYANNIS: Did you talk to someone
from DHS on that yet?

PREA: I did.

NANCY FRAGOYANNIS: Okay, and what was the
story? I mean --

PREA: So the story was basically they put
it in the NOC based on something that came from Tokyo,

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1 (indiscernible, possibly mill pool), you know, and they
2 gave me the date, the date of some kind of correspondence
3 that they cited it with from the 11th saying, you know,
4 that this is like they want, they're like officially
5 asking for assistance on a nuclear incident response.

6 But looking through all the correspondence
7 from that individual, there's no actual mention of a
8 formal, like an official request for that assistance.

9 But there had been discussion through this
10 correspondence about, you know, (indiscernible, possibly
11 USC) frequently asking if they would like assistance
12 with nuclear incident response and government of Japan
13 kind of saying we're thinking about it but we're not
14 asking yet, and that's where it stands right now.

15 Talking to the task force here and our
16 coordinator as well as the RMT and the DART no one's
17 heard of any official request for assistance in that
18 regard. So I don't really know where that came from
19 but it seems that that's not an official request and
20 that we've been offering.

21 NANCY FRAGOYANNIS: Okay, because we were
22 just, you know, hoping we didn't drop the ball on something
23 here and we hadn't heard anything about an official request
24 so when we saw that it was like try and track it down.
25 Okay.

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1 PREA: Yes. So, no, I think all of us agree
2 that there is no official request and in all of the
3 interagency calls and all of our calls with Embassy Tokyo
4 we have not heard anything about a request being mismanaged
5 or anything like that.

6 NANCY FRAGOYANNIS: Okay. All right, great.
7 That's exactly what I wanted to hear.

8 PREA: All right.

9 NANCY FRAGOYANNIS: Thank you.

10 PREA: Thanks. Bye-bye.

11 NANCY FRAGOYANNIS: Bye-bye.

14 requested U.S. technical assistance with cooling of the
15 reactors at 1, 2 and 3 at Fukushima.

16 PREA: They have requested?

17 NANCY FRAGOYANNIS: They have requested
18 technical assistance with cooling the reactors.

19 PREA: Okay.

20 NANCY FRAGOYANNIS: And this effort is being
21 coordinated by the U.S. ambassador there in Japan.

22 PREA: Okay, and has the DART in Japan been
23 made aware of this?

24 NANCY FRAGOYANNIS: I don't know.

25 (Pause.)

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1 NANCY FRAGOYANNIS: Yes, it's all coming
2 from the Embassy so -- wait a second. Hold on a second.

3 (Pause.)

4 NANCY FRAGOYANNIS: Okay, so we emailed our
5 contact at USAID so he's aware so I guess it's going
6 to go through the chain now.

7 PREA: Okay, great. And this was a new
8 request as of what time?

9 NANCY FRAGOYANNIS: 5:50.

10 PREA: 5:50.

11 NANCY FRAGOYANNIS: Yes.

12 PREA: Okay, great. Thanks very much.

13 NANCY FRAGOYANNIS: Okay.

14 PREA: Bye-bye.

15 NANCY FRAGOYANNIS: Bye-bye.

10 Fragoyannis again.

12 NANCY FRAGOYANNIS: Okay, we're going to

16 your DoDs and that kind of thing, because we're looking

21 basically a conference call. I think the best for those
22 of kinds of assets, probably working through the RMT.

24 PREA: It's the Response Management Team
25 here that's through OFDA. That's basically lead on the

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1 response on the ground and they're coordinating basically
2 DoD assets as well, so --

3 NANCY FRAGOYANNIS: Okay, so they're
4 coordinating DoD assets as well. Okay, that's what we're
5 looking for.

6 PREA: Yes, so kind of everyone working
7 together figuring out what's needed.

8 NANCY FRAGOYANNIS: Okay, that's what we're
9 looking for.

10 PREA: So what's the best number to reach
11 you?

12 NANCY FRAGOYANNIS: Hold on a second. Oh,
13 you mean just to start setting this up or a conference
14 call number to have everyone call in?

15 PREA: Just to start setting this up.

16 NANCY FRAGOYANNIS: Okay, you can call me.

17 (Pause.)

18 NANCY FRAGOYANNIS: Oh, it's 301-816-5192.

19 PREA: 5192. Nancy, how do you spell your
20 last name?

21 NANCY FRAGOYANNIS: It's
22 F-R-A-G-O-Y-A-N-N-I-S.

4 can I help you?

5 NANCY FRAGOYANNIS: Hi. Is Prea (phonetic)
6 in, please?

7 FEMALE PARTICIPANT: Sure, hold on.

8 (Pause.)

9 PREA: This is Prea.

10 NANCY FRAGOYANNIS: Prea, hi. Nancy
11 Fragoyannis from NRC.

12 PREA: Hi.

13 NANCY FRAGOYANNIS: Anything on the
14 conference call?

15 PREA: Yes, so actually we just had a DART
16 call with our folks in the field and this request hasn't
17 been validated yet so the ambassador hasn't talked to
18 the DART at all about this.

19 NANCY FRAGOYANNIS: Okay.

20 PREA: And as far as a formal request coming
21 through the NRC liaison on the DART, he hasn't expressed
22 any of that to the DART leadership so none of us know
23 about it.

24 In about half an hour the DART leader is
25 having a meeting with the ambassador at which time, you

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1 know, we discuss with him clarifying these issues and
2 finding out what exactly is necessary.

3 During that meeting, if the request has been
4 officially made, we'll consider that validated and the
5 RMT will approach the administrator of AID for additional
6 funding and that sort of thing to go ahead with mobilizing
7 that.

8 The RMT response manager is fully aware of
9 these issues and has your contact information as well
10 as the, I guess your representative on the RMT.

11 NANCY FRAGOYANNIS: Okay. So let me make
12 sure I have this because our people here are getting
13 really anxious right now because we got to get this moving.

14 So you're waiting for an official request from the
15 ambassador.

16 PREA: Right, so (inaudible) expressed to
17 me that basically the mechanism that the request was
18 made was through the Embassy, through the ambassador.

19 NANCY FRAGOYANNIS: It has to go to the
20 ambassador to the DART.

21 PREA: Right and it has to go to the DART
22 because the Embassy itself isn't going to provide those
23 assets.

24 NANCY FRAGOYANNIS: Okay, sure, sure.

25 PREA: But that request hasn't been made

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1 or discussed with the DART at this point so our people
2 in the field aren't aware of it. Until they are, it's
3 not possible for it to go up our chain.

4 NANCY FRAGOYANNIS: Okay, so in a half hour
5 the ambassador's meeting with the DART person?

6 PREA: Yes, that's right.

7 NANCY FRAGOYANNIS: Okay, I'm just trying
8 to get this down so I can pass it along (inaudible).

9 PREA: Yes, sure. That's just fine.

10 NANCY FRAGOYANNIS: Okay, DART person.

11 PREA: To the DART leadership, yes.

12 NANCY FRAGOYANNIS: DART leadership, okay.

13 PREA: And the other thing, and so basically
14 we need to have this validated, this request validated
15 by the ambassador before we can start mobilizing, at
16 which point a conference call will be made and --

17 NANCY FRAGOYANNIS: Right, because what
18 they're -- I'm sorry, go ahead.

19 PREA: Sorry. Well, there is a 10:00 a.m.
20 interagency call where all the players that we would
21 want would be on the call anyway so we're aiming for
22 that if possible, but before we even get that far we
23 need to have the request actually formally made and passed
24 on to the response team.

25 NANCY FRAGOYANNIS: Okay, so you're thinking

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1 about having this conference call at the same time that
2 we would have the interagency call like we had at 3:00?

3 PREA: Yes or just at least express that
4 this was something that's happening. Like, I'm not even
5 going to put it on the agenda until we've had it validated.

6 NANCY FRAGOYANNIS: Okay. Is there any way
7 we can have it sooner if this gets validated sooner?

8 PREA: I'm not sure. You'd have to talk
9 to the response manager for that.

10 NANCY FRAGOYANNIS: Okay, and he's going
11 to call me?

12 PREA: The response manager, she has your
13 phone number and the other person, you know, you probably
14 want to be able to get in touch with is the NRC representative
15 that you have --

16 NANCY FRAGOYANNIS: I think they already
17 did. My understanding was they already contacted him
18 about it.

19 PREA: No. Yes, I contacted him about it
20 but you might want to, you know, keep the avenues open
21 between each other, like NRC to NRC on the, you know.

22 NANCY FRAGOYANNIS: Yes, I think someone
23 already contacted him.

24 PREA: Okay, great.

25 NANCY FRAGOYANNIS: But I could verify that.

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1 PREA: Because he's sitting there in the
2 RMT and I am actually sitting at State --

3 NANCY FRAGOYANNIS: Oh, okay.

4 PREA: -- he would be able to get you answers
5 more quickly because he's sitting in the response room.

6 NANCY FRAGOYANNIS: Okay. Can you help me
7 with a State Department question then? What about visas
8 and passports and that for Japan for our employees?

9 PREA: For Japan (inaudible).

10 NANCY FRAGOYANNIS: Yes.

11 PREA: I think Consular Affairs would be
12 able to help you on the task force.

13 NANCY FRAGOYANNIS: Okay, so there's a
14 Consular Affairs on the task force.

15 PREA: Yes.

16 NANCY FRAGOYANNIS: Okay. Yes, because
17 they were on it, okay, (indiscernible, possibly con/task
18 force), okay.

19 PREA: You would be able to ask them and
20 does that help?

21 NANCY FRAGOYANNIS: Yes.

15 I need to get over to Dave Skeen in the Reactor Safety
16 Team area.

17 ERIC: Okay.

18 JACK RAMSEY: Okay? Basically they are
19 believing that the core for Unit 2 is uncovered.

20 ERIC: Okay. Let me go run over and get
21 Dave Skeen.

22 JACK RAMSEY: Okay.

23 ERIC: Hold on.

24 JACK RAMSEY: Or if you have a number for
25 him, I can call that number, either way.

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1 ERIC: All right, hold on. Let me run over
2 and see if he's there. One second.

3 (Pause.)

4 ERIC: Hey, Jack. Dave Skeen just went over
5 to the (inaudible) but Peter Alter is here. He's going
6 to listen up.

7 JACK RAMSEY: Okay.

8 PETER ALTER: Peter Alter, RST coordinator.

9 JACK RAMSEY: Oh, hey, it's Jack Ramsey from
10 over in IP.

11 PETER ALTER: Yes.

12 JACK RAMSEY: Hey, I wanted to pass on to
13 you guys, I got an email from one of my Japanese points

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1 is. I set it on the desk right in front of you but that
2 doesn't help me a bit.

5 to type it in. What is it again?

6 PETER ALTER: Okay, it's RST01.hoc.

2 we can get back in touch with him as soon as we know
3 what's going on, if he has a cell phone or anything.

4 ANDREA JONES: Do you have his phone number
5 and his email and his cell phone? So she's going to
6 send it to him.

7 MARY: Okay, and then what we will do is
8 as soon as we know something we'll include him on all
9 communications.

10 ANDREA JONES: Okay, hold on. Is he, like,
11 wanting to check in now because they don't have anything
12 arranged for him yet? Hold on.

13 RANI FRANOVICH: Hi, Mary. This is Rani
14 Franovich.

15 MARY: Hi.

16 RANI FRANOVICH: How you doing?

17 MARY: I'm fine.

18 RANI FRANOVICH: Good. He called and he
19 said he had some information that he was staying at a
20 hotel. He was thinking it was Okahura (phonetic) or
21 something like that.

22 MARY: (b)(6)

23 RANI FRANOVICH: (b)(6)

24 MARY: Is he staying there?

25 RANI FRANOVICH: Well, the information he

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1 has indicates that he is.

2 MARY: Okay, so somebody probably booked
3 that for him. The (b)(6) is a hotel in Tokyo.

4 RANI FRANOVICH: Okay, that sounds right.

5 MARY: Okay. I did not book it for him.
6 I don't know who booked it.

7 RANI FRANOVICH: That's okay. That's okay.
8 Can you tell me how it's spelled? I can do a Google
9 --

10 MARY: (b)(6)

11 RANI FRANOVICH: (b)(6) So
12 what I'm going to do is I'm just going to Google it and
13 send him the name of it and the address by email.

14 MARY: Oh, at the (b)(6) I can find
15 it for you right now. Hold on just a second. I don't
16 know if the Embassy booked this for him. Now, there
17 are two hotels in Tokyo called the (b)(6) so I'll give
18 you -- oh, I don't even know which one it is, but okay.

19 RANI FRANOVICH: I'll send the information
20 on both but it might be easier, Mary, for me to just
21 Google this.

22 MARY: Well, I mean, okay. The thing is
23 there are two hotels and then there's another one that
24 has the word (b)(6) in it. All right, the address --
25 are you ready?

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1 RANI FRANOVICH: Yes.

2 MARY: Okay. This is (b)(6)

3 (b)(6)

4 (b)(6)

5 And the phone number is 81, that's for Japan,

6 city code

(b)(6)

7 RANI FRANOVICH: Okay.

8 MARY: All right, now let me give you the
9 other one. This is the one that I think it is that he
10 was staying and that he's staying in but --

11 RANI FRANOVICH: Okay, so the second one
12 is the one you believe may be more likely?

13 MARY: No, I think the one that I just did
14 but I want to make sure that --

15 RANI FRANOVICH: He's got both just in case.

16 MARY: If it's another one. It's giving
17 me two descriptions of the hotel. When I look at (b)(6)

18 (b)(6) I get two descriptions. He'd be the one in Tokyo
19 proper, right?

20 RANI FRANOVICH: Whichever one is closest
21 to the Embassy I would imagine.

22 MARY: Okay, the Hotel (b)(6) is
23 probably the one we have since he's leaving. All right,
24 use that one. Use what I gave you. That should be fine.

25 RANI FRANOVICH: Okay.

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1 MARY: I think that's it so --

2 RANI FRANOVICH: Okay, great.

3 MARY: All right, thanks.

4 RANI FRANOVICH: Thank you.

5 MARY: Okay, bye-bye.

6 RANI FRANOVICH: Bye.

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(CONFERENCE CALL INITIATED)

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JANE: International Programs.

ANDREA JONES: Hey, Jane.

JANE: Hi.

ANDREA JONES: It's me, Andrea.

JANE: Yes.

ANDREA JONES: Are you putting together, or if you're not I would like to ask you to do it, a call list for the people that are going over, the NRC team that's going over that includes Kirk and Brooke?

JANE: Yes. Margie (phonetic) asked me to just put a list of names and I'm trying to gather BlackBerry numbers, so I have Kirk and Brooke's but I have to get the other four.

ANDREA JONES: And emergency contacts.

JANE: Okay. But I will add that. What else?

ANDREA JONES: BlackBerry numbers.

JANE: Yes, I have that.

ANDREA JONES: Email.

JANE: Okay.

ANDREA JONES: And emergency family contact, for example it would be like Kirk's (b)(6) or Brooke's (b)(6) with their numbers.

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1 JANE: Okay, emergency contact name and
2 number.

3 ANDREA JONES: Yes.

4 JANE: Okay, I have first name, last name,
5 BlackBerry number, emergency contact name and number
6 and email.

7 ANDREA JONES: Yes, so that's for Chuck,
8 Charles Casto, Brooke Smith, John Monninger.

9 JANE: Right, Kirk, Anthony Ulses, whatever,
10 and James Trapp.

11 ANDREA JONES: And James Trapp, right.

12 JANE: I'm working on it.

13 ANDREA JONES: Mark (phonetic) -- I'm sorry.

14 JANE: That's okay.

15 (Pause.)

16 JANE: We're working on it now. It'll be
17 done next two hours.

18 ANDREA JONES: Okay, thank you.

19 JANE: Okay, bye.
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1 (CONFERENCE CALL INITIATED)

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3 GARY: This is Gary (phonetic).

4 SKIP YOUNG: Gary, this is Skip Young with
5 the Nuclear Regulatory Commission.

6 GARY: Hi, Skip.

7 SKIP YOUNG: I'm in the Office of
8 International Programs.

9 GARY: Okay.

10 SKIP YOUNG: Did you talk to, your guys talk
11 about dosimetry?

12 GARY: Yes.

13 SKIP YOUNG: All these people have gone home
14 and they're packing and we were hoping to issue their
15 dosimetry at the airport.

16 GARY: Okay.

17 SKIP YOUNG: So I have dosimetry here that
18 admin has given me.

19 GARY: Okay.

20 SKIP YOUNG: Now, can they fill out the form
21 at the airport? But I guess I need your authorization
22 to issue it to them or how do we want to work this?

23 GARY: Yes, I was hoping to give them a bit
24 of a briefing, but you say they've already gone home?

25 SKIP YOUNG: They've gone home and they're

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1 packing and we're getting ready to put them on a plane
2 tonight, if you understand what I'm saying.

3 GARY: Oh, yes.

4 SKIP YOUNG: Did you want to go to the airport
5 and meet them?

6 GARY: Well, who's going? Do you have a
7 list of names and are they experienced as I imagine they
8 are or --

9 SKIP YOUNG: Two of them are out of our office,
10 okay?

11 GARY: All right.

12 SKIP YOUNG: Okay, so it's Kirk Foggie and
13 --

14 GARY: It's who?

15 SKIP YOUNG: Kirk Foggie and --

16 GARY: I can't understand that. Kirk --

17 SKIP YOUNG: Foggie.

18 GARY: How do you spell that?

19 SKIP YOUNG: F-O-G-G-I-E.

20 GARY: Kirk Foggie, okay.

21 SKIP YOUNG: Brooke Smith.

22 GARY: Brooke Smith, okay. All right.

23 SKIP YOUNG: Okay, those people are out of
24 the Office of International Programs.

25 GARY: Okay.

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1 SKIP YOUNG: My expectation is that when
2 they go in country they're going to be at the Embassy
3 and we're going to give them dosimetry but they're not
4 going to go out in the field, if you understand what
5 I'm saying.

6 GARY: Yes.

7 SKIP YOUNG: The other four that are going
8 with the team are very experienced. They're going to
9 be HPs or nuc engineers, if you understand what I'm saying.

10 GARY: Okay.

11 SKIP YOUNG: So the actual people that are
12 going to be on the ground I think are going to be very
13 experienced people.

14 GARY: Do you have their names?

15 SKIP YOUNG: The answer is I do have their
16 names.

17 (Pause.)

18 ANDREA JONES: Hello.

19 GARY: Hello.

20 ANDREA JONES: Hi, you need the names of
21 the people?

22 GARY: Well, yes. I'd like to have the names.

23 ANDREA JONES: Okay, Charles Casto.

24 GARY: Charles Casto, Chuck Casto?

25 ANDREA JONES: Yes.

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1 GARY: Okay.

2 ANDREA JONES: Yes, I didn't know -- trying
3 to be proper. John Monninger.

4 GARY: John Monninger, okay.

5 ANDREA JONES: There's a Tony
6 N-A-K-A-N-I-S-H-I, Tony N-A-K-A-N-I-S-H-I.

7 GARY: Okay.

8 ANDREA JONES: Tim K-O-L-B.

9 GARY: Oh, Tim Kolb's going. Okay.

10 ANDREA JONES: Jack Foster.

11 GARY: Okay.

12 ANDREA JONES: Richard D as in dog, D-E-V
13 as in Victor, E-R-C-E-L-L-Y.

14 GARY: Okay.

15 ANDREA JONES: And then we have Kirk. You
16 have Kirk Foggie?

17 GARY: Yes.

18 ANDREA JONES: And you have Brooke with an
19 E, B-R-O-O-K-E.

20 GARY: Okay. Brooke Smith, yes.

21 ANDREA JONES: And there may be an additional
22 person but I don't know who -- I just heard it.

23 GARY: Okay. Well, I guess I could find
24 the form, and who's going to take the badges out to the
25 airport to them?

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1 ANDREA JONES: I have no idea.

2 GARY: Okay.

3 ANDREA JONES: I don't know who's going to
4 take the badges out to the airport.

5 GARY: Okay. Well, somebody's going to have
6 to, right?

7 ANDREA JONES: Yes.

8 GARY: Or you're going to have to have some
9 kind of arrangement.

10 ANDREA JONES: I mean, we could probably
11 --

12 GARY: What airport are they going out of?

13 ANDREA JONES: I don't even know. I don't
14 know the flight arrangements. I was just handed the
15 phone. I'm sorry. I guess we could get the badges to
16 Kirk or Brooke.

17 GARY: Okay, are they still here?

18 ANDREA JONES: No, but they probably -- I
19 think one of them could come by the office.

20 GARY: Okay.

21 ANDREA JONES: So maybe Kirk.

22 GARY: Is Trish Milligan around?

23 ANDREA JONES: No, not in this room.

24 GARY: Okay. You know, some of this should
25 have been planned and part of an emergency response plan.

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1 You know, get a chance to get a little bit of a briefing,
2 you know?

3 ANDREA JONES: Yes.

4 GARY: Instead of just sending them off into
5 the dark.

6 ANDREA JONES: Yes.

7 GARY: Well, I'll find the forms but you're
8 going to have to essentially, I hate to say the Incident
9 Response Center, somebody's going to take responsibility
10 for doing things right, you know, knowing what to do
11 and doing it. You know, there's things that they can
12 and can't do and things that they should understand so
13 --

14 ANDREA JONES: Well, I'm sure there'll be
15 --

16 GARY: If Tim Kolb was still here I could
17 brief him.

18 ANDREA JONES: Let me let you talk back to
19 Skip because I'm really kind of just giving you the names.
20 And the information that you're telling me, I mean,
21 it's helpful but it's kind of not using the right ear
22 so --

23 GARY: Yes, I hear you. All right, let me
24 talk to Skip.

25 SKIP YOUNG: Hello.

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1 GARY: Hey, Skip.

2 SKIP YOUNG: How are you?

3 GARY: Good. Okay, Skip, has any of this
4 been pre-planned? I mean have these people had any
5 instruction? Do they know how to handle dosimeters,
6 they know what to do, not to run them through the luggage
7 machine, do they know how to work, they know what it
8 measures? You know, is there any --

9 SKIP YOUNG: Yes, in other words, the people
10 they have selected are pretty senior people that
11 understand, that have been out. In other words, these
12 are experts that have the background. In other words,
13 these are BWRs and HPs that they're sending.

14 GARY: Yes, there aren't any HPs in there,
15 are there?

16 SKIP YOUNG: The answer is I could find an
17 HP and I can ask the HP that's in the group to give the
18 other group, you know, the basic --

19 GARY: Well, that would be great. That would
20 help a lot. But I don't see -- maybe there's an HP I
21 don't know.

22 SKIP YOUNG: Well, you're probably -- maybe
23 these are --

24 GARY: I'm an HP.

25 SKIP YOUNG: Yes, well.

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1 GARY: And I don't know any of these people.

2 SKIP YOUNG: Okay. I was told that we were
3 sending HPs and engineers, if you understand what I'm
4 saying.

5 GARY: Yes.

6 SKIP YOUNG: And if you're saying there's
7 no HPs on there, then there's no HPs on there.

8 GARY: Well, you know, it's possible there's
9 somebody from FSME or something and I don't know. I
10 don't know. Chuck Casto's Region IV. John Monninger
11 is a manager. I don't know Tony Nakanishi and I know
12 Tim Kolb real well but he's an operator. And Jack Foster,
13 I don't know who that is and Richard --

14 SKIP YOUNG: I know Foster's not an HP, I'm
15 pretty sure.

16 GARY: Richard Devercelly, I don't know who
17 he is.

18 SKIP YOUNG: How would you like to proceed?

19 GARY: Well, do you have a plan on how you're
20 going to get these badges to the airport because I hear
21 these guys are already gone?

22 SKIP YOUNG: The answer is we're going to
23 -- Kirk Foggie is local. Kirk is in the Office of
24 International Programs.

25 GARY: Okay.

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1 SKIP YOUNG: We're putting booklets together
2 for them. We were going to put the dosimetry and the
3 booklets together and hand each team member a booklet
4 and their dosimetry. So Kirk was actually going to be
5 the one that was going to --

6 GARY: Okay. Is he here where I could brief
7 him? I'm sorry, is he coming back?

8 SKIP YOUNG: We were actually going to take
9 the material over to his house. So the answer is I can
10 have Kirk give you a call, if you understand what I'm
11 saying.

12 GARY: Yes. Why don't you do that?

13 SKIP YOUNG: Okay.

14 GARY: Why don't you have Kirk give me a
15 call? I'm going to try to get hold of Tim Kolb too.

16 SKIP YOUNG: Okay.

17 GARY: I don't want to make this too big
18 a deal but, you know, (indiscernible, possibly you're
19 supposed to do things somewhat right,) you know.

20 SKIP YOUNG: Yes, yes, yes. I have a whole
21 stack of dosimetry so I do not need all these. I'm going
22 to give most of them back except for the ones that we
23 need to take, if you understand what I'm saying.

24 GARY: Yes, they should take couple extra
25 for controls.

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1 SKIP YOUNG: Okay.

2 GARY: And what that means is that they should
3 basically keep all the dosimeters together unless
4 somebody's wearing them, and then that's fine. The
5 controls would stay in the hotel or something like that
6 where it's not exposed.

7 SKIP YOUNG: All right. I haven't counted
8 the number I have here but it looks like I may have,
9 you may have given us 20. Does that sound right?

10 GARY: Okay, I don't know, very possibly.
11 You know, I haven't been involved. I don't know.

12 SKIP YOUNG: I've got 16 or 17 dosimetry.

13 GARY: Okay.

14 SKIP YOUNG: Okay, so --

15 GARY: So if you would label a couple of
16 them control.

17 SKIP YOUNG: All right.

18 GARY: And maybe put a note on there, "Keep
19 in hotel room," or something like that. But I'd like
20 to brief them to not run them through the x-ray machines
21 because, you know, if they throw them in their luggage
22 and throw them through the industrial x-ray machines,
23 they're going to get 300 or 400 millirem (inaudible)
24 right there.

25 SKIP YOUNG: Yes, yes, yes. They're going

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1 to be useless if we run them through. Okay. Let me try
2 to get a hold of Kirk and are you here at the office
3 or am I calling --

4 GARY: Yes.

5 SKIP YOUNG: Okay. So where are you
6 physically located?

7 GARY: Seventh floor, (inaudible), seventh
8 floor.

9 SKIP YOUNG: Okay.

10 GARY: And my phone number is 4 --

11 SKIP YOUNG: 415-2766.

12 GARY: Yes, my cell is (b)(6) --

13 SKIP YOUNG: (b)(6) --

14 GARY: No.

15 SKIP YOUNG: 415-2766.

16 GARY: Close. No, that's my office number,
17 415-2766.

18 SKIP YOUNG: Okay.

19 GARY: My cell phone is (b)(6) -- got it?

20 SKIP YOUNG: (b)(6)

21 GARY: Yes, (b)(6) --

22 SKIP YOUNG: (b)(6)

23 GARY: (b)(6)

24 SKIP YOUNG: (b)(6)

25 GARY: Yes.

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1 SKIP YOUNG: And you're on the seventh floor?

2 GARY: Yes.

3 SKIP YOUNG: Maybe the best thing for me
4 to do is walk over to your office and give Kirk a call
5 from your office and that way, he --

6 GARY: That'll be fine.

7 SKIP YOUNG: I'll bring the dosimetry over
8 here and you can do a couple things with it to make sure
9 we're doing the right thing.

10 GARY: Okay.

11 SKIP YOUNG: How's that?

12 GARY: All right.

13 SKIP YOUNG: And you're on 7 --

14 GARY: 7-E18.

15 SKIP YOUNG: E18.

16 GARY: That's on the north side, on the side
17 of the new building.

18 SKIP YOUNG: Okay, okay. All right. Bye.

19 GARY: Okay, bye.

5 JACK: Okay, we got the one from Region II,
6 one from Chattanooga and the rest from headquarters.

7 GLENN TRACY: Understood.

8 JACK: The earliest commercial is 1:00 p.m.
9 tomorrow. Margie (phonetic), we talked to the ET,
10 Borchardt's heading ET up. Margie said, hey, why don't
11 we see if Defense can help us, okay? I called the White
12 House. They said, yes, we'll get you a point of contact.

13 I'm now starting to see an email string from DoD saying
14 they're going to look at what assets they may have to
15 try to help us.

16 GLENN TRACY: Sure.

17 JACK: Okay? I need a coordinator. I need
18 a point of contact for whoever is going to talk to and
19 organize all these people to go just on the off chance
20 that DoD comes through.

21 GLENN TRACY: Right. But, I mean, who
22 normally handles travel for our side, in other words?
23 That would be the point of contact, (indiscernible,
24 possibly CFO,) right?

25 JACK: No. How many times have we had a

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1 three melt accident in Japan? I mean, I'm thinking
2 somebody for continuity purposes, somebody in the Op
3 Center may have been designated to be the focal point
4 to talk to for all this stuff.

5 GLENN TRACY: Oh, yes, okay. I've got to
6 put my hat on. I was in here to make sure these people
7 were getting medically screened and I'm not in the Op
8 Center per se for this, so the phone was handed to me
9 in an unusual center. I don't understand why we're not
10 set up in such a fashion to do this.

11 JACK: Yes, yes. I mean, it could very well
12 be we say International Liaison does it. I'm okay with
13 that, but I just need to know. Okay, it's not a question
14 of paying for it. It's not a question of --

15 GLENN TRACY: I get it. I personally think
16 in this case because it's three at the desk that that
17 would be the way to go until we set up a (indiscernible,
18 possibly corporate support thing only because right now
19 there is no corporate) support. You know, and as much
20 as I'm ready to start making a team, which I think you'll
21 be impressed with because we've already been working
22 (indiscernible, possibly with the NLE), you know what
23 I mean?

24 JACK: Yes, yes.

25 GLENN TRACY: It doesn't exist as of right

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1 now.

2 JACK: Yes, yes, yes, yes. Okay, well, then
3 can I talk to Charlotte for a second?

4 GLENN TRACY: Yes, but I mean I'm not trying
5 to pass the buck for you. I hope you know that.

6 JACK: No. No, I'm just going to ask her
7 if she'll do it. She's there --

8 GLENN TRACY: Yes, or she has three people,
9 you know what I mean, right here.

10 JACK: Right, okay.

11 GLENN TRACY: Okay? And then I guess my
12 only other point is the medical screening, my good friend,
13 should these people be getting a medical screening before
14 they go? Is it your understanding they're just going
15 to be in Tokyo in the Embassy or could it possibly be
16 that they would be sent elsewhere?

17 JACK: Here's the thing, yesterday afternoon
18 120 nautical miles east of Fukushima the Ronald Reagan
19 carrier picked up 1 mR per hour. So even if they're
20 in Tokyo they (indiscernible, possibly need the dose.)

21 GLENN TRACY: I concur. That's my point.

22 JACK: Is there time? I mean, if --

23 GLENN TRACY: I have the health center
24 standing by was my point and I did it at noon or 11:30
25 when I got the announcement so I just want to (indiscernible,

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1 possibly make sure.)

2 JACK: You know, I would say that we would
3 probably be best off sending the headquarters people
4 down just --

5 GLENN TRACY: I concur.

6 JACK: -- for a quick thing. What to do
7 for Chuck and the guy from TTC, I --

8 GLENN TRACY: Well, I gave them direction.
9 For all I know, they could easily have used their
10 (indiscernible, possibly docket.) We paid for it. I
11 don't really care.

12 JACK: Yes. Okay, yes, I don't care either
13 (inaudible).

14 GLENN TRACY: Okay. But I'm going to have
15 Charlotte because the desk here, I think that's the right
16 answer for the other one so that when they come down
17 with the flight, your people -- see, I'll be quite frank.

18 Sally Billings was running this but then it became an
19 international matter. It's all lessons learned from
20 how we're going to do this long term in my view in terms
21 of the support structure, okay?

22 JACK: Yes.

23 GLENN TRACY: Are you cool?

24 JACK: Yes, absolutely.

25 GLENN TRACY: Great.

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1 JACK: Thank you.

2 (Pause.)

3 CHARLOTTE: I'm going to let you tell this
4 to Andrea because I'm trying to run down something else.
5 Is that okay?

6 JACK: Okay. Yes, sure.

7 CHARLOTTE: Okay.

8 ANDREA JONES: Yes, Jack.

9 JACK: Hey, what I need, okay, and what I
10 think Charlotte and I are hoping that you can do, are
11 you there through 11:00?

22 we're trying to get resolved is, you know, the first
23 commercial flight is 1:00 p.m. tomorrow.

24 ANDREA JONES: Right.

25 JACK: Okay? The Defense Department is

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1 going to see if they can help us with getting transportation,
2 Defense military transportation, okay. We're going to
3 run both in parallel. What I'd like to do is I would
4 like to go and send something out that says coordinate
5 all this through the international liaison function which
6 can be reached at the following email addresses and the
7 following phone numbers.

8 ANDREA JONES: Okay.

9 JACK: Okay? With a cc to all of our
10 potential travelers.

11 ANDREA JONES: Okay.

12 JACK: So if that sounds reasonable, okay.

13 ANDREA JONES: Yes, okay. It should be
14 someone here. So you just want us to serve as point
15 of contact?

16 JACK: Point of contact and coordinator.
17 Like, you know, if Chuck Casto from Region II, let's
18 say DoD turns around and says we have a plane, okay?
19 People are going to need to know where they need to be
20 and when they need to be there and all these other kinds
21 of things while we're working this between now and whenever,
22 however --

23 ANDREA JONES: Okay.

24 JACK: Okay? I guess the latest we could
25 work is 1:00 p.m. tomorrow because that's when the

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1 commercial flight leaves.

2 ANDREA JONES: Okay.

3 JACK: So, all right, I will do that. What
4 is it, LIA02 and 03?

5 ANDREA JONES: LIA03 and 02.

6 JACK: Okay.

7 ANDREA JONES: And, yes, and the number --

8 JACK: At nrc.gov?

9 ANDREA JONES: No, at HOC.

10 JACK: .HOC, Headquarters Operations
11 Center.

12 ANDREA JONES: HOC@nrc.gov?

13 JACK: Yes.

14 ANDREA JONES: So it's no space between the
15 03 -- .hoc, LIA03.hoc@nrc.

16 JACK: Yes, and then LIA02. I got you.

17 ANDREA JONES: Yes, okay.

18 JACK: Okay, so I'm going to send that out
19 and I'm going to make sure that you guys get copies of
20 all this.

21 ANDREA JONES: Okay.

22 JACK: All right, thank you.

23 ANDREA JONES: I don't know if you know this
24 question. Thetravelers, who'sgettingtheminformation?

25 JACK: That's what I just asked you guys

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1 to do.

KEVIN QUINLAN: Hi, Mr. Skoczlas, my name is Kevin Quinlan with the United States Nuclear Regulator Commission.

JOHN SKOCZLAS: Okay.

KEVIN QUINLAN: I was told that you were just on a conference call with us not to long ago and NOAA had stated that there was a 19 mile plume of radiation moving South --

JOHN SKOCZLAS: No, no, no, no. I said that the Japanese meteorological Agency issued a SIGMET, that's a significant meteorological message --

KEVIN QUINLAN: Okay.

JOHN SKOCZLAS: -- for aircraft that says there's a radiation within 19 miles of it.

KEVIN QUINLAN: Okay, radiation --

JOHN SKOCZLAS: So it's just relating this is actual, was out there this morning. They issued a SIGMET, what we call, letting pilots know that there's a potential radiation at a certain level and it didn't go up to the height level or it didn't say what level what it was in that area. Right around the nuclear power plant.

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1 KEVIN QUINLAN: Okay, I'm sorry, John.
2 Because whoever was on our end got that message severely
3 wrong.

4 JOHN SKOCZLAS: Yes, thank you so much for
5 calling me and getting it clarified.

6 KEVINQUINLAN: Yes, sorry, as people started
7 to panic a little bit. So they'll be, all right, so
8 JMA issued significant meteorological statement.

9 JOHN SKOCZLAS: And it's called a SIGMET.

10 KEVIN QUINLAN: SIGMET, okay.

11 JOHN SKOCZLAS: It's for the airlines.

12 KEVIN QUINLAN: So, okay.

13 JOHN SKOCZLAS: You know, that within 30
14 kilometers, about 19 miles. I think that was the

Commission, please hold. Thank you for holding, how
may I help you?

CYNTHIA BARR: Can I get Steve Klementowicz
please?

OPERATOR: Spell the last name.

CYNTHIA BARR: It starts with K-L-E-M --

OPERATOR: You said K?

CYNTHIA BARR: Yes, sir.

OPERATOR: You said K what now?

CYNTHIA BARR: L-E-M, Klementowicz, Steve.

STEVE KLEMENTOWICZ: Hello, Steve
Klementowicz speaking.

releases from the Fukushima Facility. Could you help
me track that down or tell me where I should look?

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1 STEVE KLEMENTOWICZ: Let's see, in Part 20
2 we have a section on reports, Subpart M 20.2201. Let's
3 see now, that's on theft or lost of license material,
4 which could be a release.

5 CYNTHIA BARR: I'm going to see if I can
6 log in.

7 STEVE KLEMENTOWICZ: And then 20.2202,
8 Notification of Incidents. "An individual who received
9 25 rem, a lens dose of 75, a shallow-dose equivalent
10 to the skin or extremities, 250 rads.

11 The release of radioactive material inside
12 or outside of a restricted area such that an individual
13 in 24 hours could have received an intake of five times
14 the annual limit."

15 CYNTHIA BARR: Okay. Of 100, so --

16 STEVE KLEMENTOWICZ: No, not of 100.

17 CYNTHIA BARR: Five times the limit of, for
18 the reactor facility which is only ten?

19 STEVE KLEMENTOWICZ: No, that's for the --

20 CYNTHIA BARR: The tech spec.

21 STEVE KLEMENTOWICZ: --public, public dose.
22 What's in, has an individual been (inaudible) --

23 CYNTHIA BARR: Oh, I though the public dose
24 was 100?

25 STEVE KLEMENTOWICZ: That's an ALI, so

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1 that's Appendix B territory where they have the annual
2 limits of concentration.

3 CYNTHIA BARR: Yes, those are based on 50
4 millirem. But when you, I'm sorry, I need to go over
5 the regulation I guess. I'm just sitting down here
6 innocently and they put me to work. I was just trying
7 to observe because I'm suppose to be working and they're
8 like, go find out (inaudible).

9 STEVE KLEMENTOWICZ: Well ALIs are for
10 occupational values, which are based on five rem in a
11 year.

12 CYNTHIA BARR: Right, but is five times the
13 annual limit referring to the, what limit are they
14 referring to?

15 STEVE KLEMENTOWICZ: Well --

16 CYNTHIA BARR: The public is 100 millirem
17 --

18 STEVE KLEMENTOWICZ: Oh, yes.

19 CYNTHIA BARR: -- I realize the worker is
20 five.

21 STEVE KLEMENTOWICZ: I know, but I'm just
22 because some manager over there wants something doesn't
23 mean we actual have a specific reporting requirement
24 for their needs.

25 CYNTHIA BARR: Okay, well that's an answer

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1 too. That's okay.

2 STEVE KLEMENTOWICZ: So that's why, going
3 through the regs, that's immediate notification and --

4 CYNTHIA BARR: This is 3.2002. I'm having
5 Duane look too at the same time. I'm sorry.

6 STEVE KLEMENTOWICZ: Yes.

7 CYNTHIA BARR: Don't we have regs sitting
8 around here somewhere?

9 DUANE SCHMIDT: I didn't find them.

10 CYNTHIA BARR: Because I can't even log into
11 the computer.

12 STEVE KLEMENTOWICZ: I worked at the Ops
13 Center for 16 years, I know your pain.

14 CYNTHIA BARR: This is my first hour.

15 STEVE KLEMENTOWICZ: May be your last.

16 CYNTHIA BARR: Exactly, they'll want to send
17 me back.

18 STEVE KLEMENTOWICZ: Let's see, this does
19 not differentiate between public or worker. It just
20 says if an individual gets these doses you shall make
21 an immediate notification.

22 And so the quantity, five times the annual
23 limit --

24 CYNTHIA BARR: Would apply to both the worker
25 and the --

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1 STEVE KLEMENTOWICZ: Yes. So if you release
2 it offsite --

3 CYNTHIA BARR: -- public.

4 STEVE KLEMENTOWICZ: -- sites and the Iodine
5 concentrations are in Appendix B --

6 CYNTHIA BARR: Okay, we have those, yes.

7 STEVE KLEMENTOWICZ: -- for the ALI's. And
8 so if you can, if the data for Iodine is available and
9 you can convert the SI units into our English units --

10 CYNTHIA BARR: I can do that.

11 STEVE KLEMENTOWICZ: -- then you can see
12 if it's five times. Now that's for immediate. Then
13 there's a 24 hour notification.

14 CYNTHIA BARR: Okay.

15 STEVE KLEMENTOWICZ: And that's to five rems
16 to a person. A lens of the I-dose of 15, a shallow-dose
17 to the skin 50 and then the release of rad material,
18 what is it here, in excess of 1 occupational ALI.

19 So if they exceeded the Iodine concentration
20 of, in our Appendix B for ALI's, then that would be a
21 24 hour notification.

22 CYNTHIA BARR: Okay.

23 STEVE KLEMENTOWICZ: So we don't go by dose,
24 we go by concentration.

25 CYNTHIA BARR: Okay.

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1 STEVE KLEMENTOWICZ: Or total --

2 CYNTHIA BARR: Well the dose to the --

3 STEVE KLEMENTOWICZ: -- total activity.

4 CYNTHIA BARR: And then is there a 30 day,
5 because that's what they could ask for? I guess they
6 think they didn't exceed the immediate or the 24 hour
7 maybe.

8 STEVE KLEMENTOWICZ: You know, it doesn't
9 --

10 CYNTHIA BARR: I'm not sure how if they
11 (inaudible) it.

12 STEVE KLEMENTOWICZ: No, it ends at that
13 point. Then we have, for power reactors, 50.72. 50.72
14 --

15 CYNTHIA BARR: Right.

16 STEVE KLEMENTOWICZ: -- and 50.73.

17 CYNTHIA BARR: Thank you. I knew that was
18 somewhere, I just couldn't recall it.

19 STEVE KLEMENTOWICZ: Okay.

20 CYNTHIA BARR: Off with my head.

21 STEVE KLEMENTOWICZ: So --

22 CYNTHIA BARR: Because I remember when I
23 worked there along long time ago.

24 STEVE KLEMENTOWICZ: Yes, that was ages.

25 CYNTHIA BARR: Somebody was working on those

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1 requirements, I remember that. I just couldn't remember
2 what those citations were.

3 Yes, I'm in waste now so I haven't been in
4 Reactors for like, almost ten years I guess. So, but
5 anyway, okay.

6 STEVE KLEMENTOWICZ: Yes, so do you have
7 10 CFR there?

8 CYNTHIA BARR: Duane's getting on the
9 internet so --

10 STEVE KLEMENTOWICZ: Oh, god.

11 CYNTHIA BARR: He got access, so we'll look
12 it up.

13 STEVE KLEMENTOWICZ: Yes, 50.72 has for --

14 CYNTHIA BARR: 50.72 and 73 have the
15 requirements for the reactors.

16 STEVE KLEMENTOWICZ: Yes, so it goes into
17 non-emergency events, four hour reports, eight hour
18 reports, and let me see.

19 CYNTHIA BARR: Can I log into this computer,
20 you can (inaudible) account or do I need to log in my
21 password -- What did you do?

22 STEVE KLEMENTOWICZ: Well that is directly
23 related to system failure at the facility. 50.73 licensee
24 event report.

25 Go into the, if you missed the tech spec

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1 condition, pending natural phenomenon or other external
2 condition that posed an actual threat to the safety of
3 the plant. And I think that happened. Automatic
4 actuation.

5 CYNTHIA BARR: I can't because it's locked.

6 DUANE SCHMIDT: Oh. There's a way to get
7 in there. There's a secret password.

8 STEVE KLEMENTOWICZ: Release of, if they've
9 control of radioactive material. Let's see, I'm not
10 getting to any dose of criteria here. Oh, here it is.

11 Any airborne radioactive release, that's
12 50.73(viii)(A).

13 CYNTHIA BARR: 50.73(viii)(A).

14 STEVE KLEMENTOWICZ: And the A is in
15 parenthesis as is the viii. Any airborne radioactive
16 --

17 CYNTHIA BARR: Viii, it's right there and
18 then A, yes.

19 STEVE KLEMENTOWICZ: So that's an airborne
20 radionuclide release that exceeds 20 times the applicable
21 concentration limits in Appendix B.

22 CYNTHIA BARR: Okay.

23 STEVE KLEMENTOWICZ: So that would refer
24 to, in Appendix B, the ECs, the effluent concentrations.

25 CYNTHIA BARR: Right, for the public.

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1 STEVE KLEMENTOWICZ: Right.

2 CYNTHIA BARR: It is a 50 millirem. Okay.

3 STEVE KLEMENTOWICZ: Well --

4 CYNTHIA BARR: Well it can be or is supposed
5 to be I guess.

6 STEVE KLEMENTOWICZ: The concentrations in
7 Table 2, the effluent concentrations, if you receive
8 that concentration averaged over the course of a year,
9 you would get 50 --

10 CYNTHIA BARR: Not.

11 STEVE KLEMENTOWICZ: -- not zero.

12 CYNTHIA BARR: Right, that's what I was
13 saying.

14 STEVE KLEMENTOWICZ: Oh -- CYNTHIA
15 BARR: What did you think I said?

16 STEVE KLEMENTOWICZ: -- I thought you said
17 15.

18 CYNTHIA BARR: No, no, 50.

19 STEVE KLEMENTOWICZ: Okay.

20 CYNTHIA BARR: Half a 100.

21 STEVE KLEMENTOWICZ: Yes.

22 CYNTHIA BARR: So that's for multiple
23 pathway. I do remember some stuff.

24 STEVE KLEMENTOWICZ: Okay, that's good.

25 CYNTHIA BARR: Okay, do you think, is it

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1 going all good, do we have everything we need? You don't
2 see anything else, do you?

13 it would be 30 days or 30. They won't use 30, T-H-I-R-T-Y.

14 STEVE KLEMENTOWICZ: So with the dose in
15 Part 20, if you exceed those values, Part 20 is clear
16 that you, immediate notifications for certain doses.
17 And then it goes down to eight hours and four hours.
18 Four hours then eight hours.

19 CYNTHIA BARR: Okay. So there is no 30 day
20 requirement anyway, you know, it seemed like there was
21 though. Or maybe you followup with a 30 day report after
22 you immediately notify or something. If I recall.

23 STEVE KLEMENTOWICZ: 20.2203, reports of
24 exposures, radiation levels and concentrations exceeding
25 the constraints or limits. That's a 30 day report.

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1 CYNTHIA BARR: Okay.

2 STEVE KLEMENTOWICZ: Okay, I just went back
3 to that section.

4 CYNTHIA BARR: Go back to 20.2203. 2203,
5 20, Part 20.

6 STEVE KLEMENTOWICZ: And that's essentially
7 if you overexpose someone. The occupational worker
8 limit.

9 CYNTHIA BARR: Right.

10 STEVE KLEMENTOWICZ: The public dose limits,
11 you know, member of the public or in ALARA constraints.

12 DUANE SCHMIDT: That's a 30 days.

13 CYNTHIA BARR: Okay, so, yes.

14 STEVE KLEMENTOWICZ: And then for
15 concentration, for a non-restricted area excess of ten
16 times any applicable limits.

17 CYNTHIA BARR: Ten times the allowable limit.
18 There you go, right there.

19 DUANE SCHMIDT: Well that's not a
20 concentration. It should be a concentration. It should
21 there.

22 CYNTHIA BARR: Well you look at the allowable
23 limit, which might be a concentration. But whether or
24 not the (inaudible) in excessive limits are 20.1301.

25 STEVE KLEMENTOWICZ: Now public dose, we

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1 only specify 100 millirem, we don't break it down into
2 organ, thyroid or anything like that.

3 CYNTHIA BARR: Right.

4 STEVE KLEMENTOWICZ: Now this rule goes on
5 to say, it talks about the EPA's standards, 40 CFR 190.
6 That's like an ALARA standard.

7 CYNTHIA BARR: That's 40 CFR, is that the
8 fuel cycle standard?

9 STEVE KLEMENTOWICZ: Yes.

10 CYNTHIA BARR: Yes, that has Iodine doses
11 in it.

12 STEVE KLEMENTOWICZ: Right, that has 25
13 whole body, 75 millirem thyroid.

14 CYNTHIA BARR: Right. 25 --

15 STEVE KLEMENTOWICZ: For whole body.

16 CYNTHIA BARR: 75 thyroid.

17 STEVE KLEMENTOWICZ: Now remember, these
18 are all --

19 CYNTHIA BARR: 25 on the other organs.

20 STEVE KLEMENTOWICZ: -- these are pre ICRP
21 26 values. So we did whole body and organ dose.

22 CYNTHIA BARR: Right.

23 STEVE KLEMENTOWICZ: It's not
24 (indiscernible, possibly PETI).

25 CYNTHIA BARR: Right..

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1 STEVE KLEMENTOWICZ: Okay, just to be sure.

2 CYNTHIA BARR: I see, RPT methodology.

3 STEVE KLEMENTOWICZ: Yes.

4 CYNTHIA BARR: But there are effluent limits
5 I think for different, also specified on 40 CFR 190 for
6 different miligases and, like krypton and I thought Iodine
7 and, yes. So that was referring to --

8 STEVE KLEMENTOWICZ: That doesn't ring a
9 bell, it shows the dose. And it includes gaseous, liquid
10 and direct --

11 CYNTHIA BARR: Yes, I know about the dose
12 part of it but I remember on Table S3 and S4, I think,
13 there was --

14 STEVE KLEMENTOWICZ: NRC's Table S3 and S4?

15 CYNTHIA BARR: Yes, in --

16 STEVE KLEMENTOWICZ: That's evaluating the
17 environmental impact of operations from mining the uranium
18 --

19 CYNTHIA BARR: Right, but I was trying to
20 remember there was, I think that was tied back to that
21 rule. And so there are limits associated with, well
22 I guess this has been considered, I'm just wondering
23 if that will get brought in too. Like you can only allow
24 a certain release of certain constituents during operation.
25 But this is an emergency situation. Yes, here it is

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1 right there.

2 STEVE KLEMENTOWICZ: Right, this Table S3
3 and S4 are for routine operations. So to assess the
4 impacts and said, here's the worse impact we can expect
5 for normal activity, normal operation. S3 is for the
6 uranium fuel cycle and that's (inaudible) of the
7 transportation of the fuel --

8 CYNTHIA BARR: Yes, I know that. I was just
9 wondering if those limits would also apply in emergency
10 situation.

11 STEVE KLEMENTOWICZ: Well that's where I'm
12 not seeing that there are limits. Licensees have to
13 ensure that they're within that criteria. So I don't
14 see them as limits.

15 CYNTHIA BARR: Okay, yes.

16 STEVE KLEMENTOWICZ: I think we're talking
17 past each other, but --

18 CYNTHIA BARR: Yes, no, I think that's fine.
19 I was just trying to recall, it was in 40 CFR 190.
20 I recalled the 25, 75, 25 and also the limits on curies
21 specific constituents.

22 STEVE KLEMENTOWICZ: Yes, that's the key
23 for 40 CFR 190.

24 CYNTHIA BARR: Yes.

25 STEVE KLEMENTOWICZ: Basically 25, 75.

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1 CYNTHIA BARR: Right. Okay, all right, is
2 that everything you can think of or do you want talk
3 a little more? You've been very helpful.

4 STEVE KLEMENTOWICZ: Oh, no, no. I'm
5 completely, is that Duane Schmidt?

6 CYNTHIA BARR: Yes, you want to talk to Duane
7 a second?

8 STEVE KLEMENTOWICZ: No, just say hi.

9 CYNTHIA BARR: Okay.

10 STEVE KLEMENTOWICZ: Have fun.
