Subject: U.S. EPR schedule clarifications - severe accident-related items

George and Mike,

I want to clarify some statements from recent correspondence on the U.S. EPR schedule to avoid any misunderstanding.

In the Feb. 6 letter "Calendar Year 2014 NRC Work Scope for the U.S. EPR Design Certification Application," AREVA anticipated that revised RAIs associated with severe accidents would be submitted in the first quarter 2014.

In the March 20 letter "Closure Plan for U.S. EPR Design Certification Application – FSAR Group B and Group C Chapters," AREVA listed the following:

RAI 553 Question 06.02.05-31	January 29, 2014 (A)
RAI 532 Q19-352	January 29, 2014 (A)
RAI 591 Q19-370	July 16, 2014 (to address comments received on Jan 29, 2014 submittal)
Severe accident audit	AREVA is working to close the severe accident-related actions in CY2014,

including RAI reconciliation.

As stated in both letters, the three severe accident-related RAIs were submitted in January. One (Q19-370) requires revision based on a telecon with the staff and will be revised on or before July 16. In addition, we are working to close the RAI reconciliation for the severe accident RAIs this year. As discussed last Monday, the SAMDA re-analysis, originally planned to be in FSAR Rev. 6, will not be performed until 2015. If you have any questions, please let me know. Thanks.
