Dear Mr. Culross:

This acknowledges receipt of your letter dated March 14, 2014, reporting an incident that occurred on December 18, 2013, in which two Peco Controls Corporation Model Gamma 101P Inspection System units, each containing 100 millicuries of americium-241, and four exit signs, each containing 11.5 curies of hydrogen-3 (tritium), could not be located. The NRC has reviewed your letter and its enclosures and has no further questions at this time. The incident will be examined during a future inspection.
