Re: Review of responses to LQD's Letter of Violation, Lost Creek ISR Project, Permit #788, Lost Creek ISR, LLC

Dear Mr. Cash:

Lost Creek ISR's (LCI's) correspondence dated February 18, 2014 was received at the Lander WDEQ/LQD office on February 19, 2014. The correspondence contained LCI's responses to LQD's previous review (dated January 22, 2014) of LCI's initial responses to the Letter of Violation (LOV) issued on December 13, 2013. LCI's responses to the six (6) comments have been reviewed and found to be acceptable. Specifically, the proposed revised language regarding the maintenance of an instantaneous, continuous bleed of 0.5% - 1.5% should be added to the Permit's Operations Plan via a non-significant revision (NSR).

It should be noted that there was no attachment accompanying the February 18, 2014 correspondence. The body of that letter indicated that Figure 1, a new water balance diagram, was attached. Please send Figure 1 either via electronic mail or regular mail. Otherwise, the only remaining action item from the December 2013 LOV is the submittal of the above-referenced NSR.
