The Fuel Manufacturing Branch, in the Division of Fuel Cycle Safety and Safeguards, requests technical assistance for the following project.

REQUESTED ACTION: Participate in a pre-application meeting with Westinghouse that is schedule for the morning of June 9, 2014. Review the License Renewal application that will be submitted by Westinghouse about two weeks after the pre-application meeting. Determine if there are major deficiencies that make the submittal unacceptable for a detailed review and prepare a recommendation to accept or not accept (if required). Prepare requests for additional information, if needed. Evaluate any additional information submitted. Participate in meetings, conference calls, and site visits, if necessary. Provide input for a Safety Evaluation Report.

The above task is estimated to require approximately 200 staff hours.
