SUMMARY

On July 23, 2013, Jay Fischer, the manager of the Portland General Electric Trojan independent spent fuel storage installation (ISFSI), responded to an e-mail request by Chris Allen to review and provide changes to the correspondence distribution list utilized by the Spent Fuel Storage and Transportation division of the Office of Nuclear Materials Safety and Safeguards. In his response, Mr. Fischer identified three intervenor organizations with whom they had not interacted in approximately ten years, and he expressed concern about the potential waste of taxpayer money in continuing to send these organizations copies of correspondence. (See attached hard copy of Mr. Fischer's e-mail.) Consequently, Chris Allen contacted Northwest Environmental Advocates and asked if they wanted to continue receiving correspondence related to the Trojan ISFSI. He spoke with a Ms. Bell who indicated that Northwest Environmental Advocates no longer wanted to be receive correspondence related to the Trojan ISFSI.
