Mr. Nelkin:

I sent the following to you in an email dated 2/5/14; as of this moment I have not gotten a reply:

*Your amendment request was assigned to me.*

*Please let me know immediately if you consider any of the information in your application to be confidential or proprietary.*

*If so, I will inform you of the procedure to follow to have the confidential information withheld from public availability. The default is that the entire application will be available for anyone to see.*

Now that I have had an opportunity to look over your amendment request, I would like to clarify whether the only change you are requesting is the addition of a distribution location at 6323 Brookhill Drive, Houston TX. Is that correct?

Please note that we cannot authorize this addition to your NRC exempt-distribution license until we have received a copy of your license from the State of Texas that authorizes possession of byproduct material at this location.

If we do not receive your reply within 30 calendar days from the date of this email, we will consider your application as having been abandoned by you. This action would be without prejudice to the resubmission of another application with the required information.

In addition, please note that our policy is to complete amendment request within 90 days of receipt. If you are unable to provide a copy of the Texas possession license to us within about 60 days, we may need to void the active control for this request. This action would also be without prejudice to the resubmission of another application with the required information.
