Dear Mr. Knotts:

In accordance with your letters dated May 31, 2006 and June 8, 2006, Georgia Radioactive Material License No. GA 1153-1 has been amended in its entirety. Enclosed is Amendment Number .23, which adds the Perfexion as a device for distribution, adds the Model 1000029 as a source for inclusion in the Leksell Gamma Systems, adds an authorized user to Condition 14.A as requested, and allows for multiple options for supervision in Condition 14.C. This amendment supersedes all previous amendments of this license.

Also enclosed is the Sealed Source and Device (SS&D) registry certificate, GA-269-D-104-S, for the Perfexion.

The following certificate amendments will be issued upon the receipt of pending information:

- An amended certificate, GA-269-S-103-S, adding the Model 1000029.
- An amended cover page for GA-269-D-102-S, reflecting the Model 1000029 as a source option for the Type B, B-2, and Type C units.

Upon completion, copies of all of the SS&D certificates will be forwarded to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission for inclusion in the national SS&D registry database.
