Subject: Response to an Apparent Violation in NRC Inspection Reports 05000295/2013404  
and 05000304/2013404; EA-14-025

Pursuant to NRC letter dated, March 6, 2014, forwarding NRC Inspection Report 05000295/2013404 and 05000304/2013404, ZionSolutions, LLC (ZionSolutions) was notified of an apparent violation of NRC requirements (Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* Parts 73.21 and 73.22) for the protection of safeguards information (SGI).

The NRC letter provided ZionSolutions the options to respond to the apparent violation within 30 days of the date of the NRC letter, or to request a Predecisional Enforcement Conference or request Alternative Dispute Resolution. On March 17, 2014, ZionSolutions informed NRC via telephone conference that it opted to respond in writing to the apparent violation.

The NRC letter also advised ZionSolutions that if it chose to provide a written response, it should be clearly marked as a "Response to an Apparent Violation in NRC Inspection Reports 05000295/2013404 and 05000304/2013404; EA-14-025," and should include: (1) the reason for the apparent violation or, if contested, the basis for disputing the apparent violation; (2) the corrective steps that have been taken and the results achieved; (3) the corrective steps that will be taken; and (4) the date when full compliance will be achieved. Also, the response should be marked, "Security-Related Information – Withhold from Public Disclosure under Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (CFR) 2.390." The NRC also waived the affidavit requirements for the response to the NRC letter.

Enclosure 1 to this letter provides ZionSolutions' response to the apparent violation in accordance with the NRC direction.
