Dear Ms. Taylor:

By this letter, we wish to advise you of a planned merger that involves Honeywell Inc., and amend our Sealed Source and Device Registry Sheets, listed above, to reflect this name change.

Honeywell Inc. is presently a wholly-owned subsidiary of Honeywell International Inc. Soon, these two legal entities will be merged into a single legal entity.

Related to the merger, there is no plan to alter any operations, procedures, personnel, sensor types, etc. relevant to the radioactive materials licenses and registrations that apply to any of the Honeywell entities, including those of Honeywell Inc. dba Honeywell - Measurex

Here are the details of the planned merger:


Starting Legal Entity	Starting Status	Status after the merger

Honeywell International	Owner of Honeywell Inc.	Remains Honeywell International.

We request that this change be effective on the completion of the merger of Honeywell, Inc. with and into Honeywell International, Inc. which we are seeking to effect at 11:59 p.m., December 31, 2001, or as soon thereafter as possible, subject to obtaining all administrative approvals.
