This concerns your request for an alternate decommissioning schedule. After reviewing your letter dated January 23, 2014, we have determined that your request lacks sufficient detail to begin a technical review. You must provide sufficient information, as required by 10 CFR 40.42(f), for the NRC to determine that delay or postponement of decommissioning activities would not be detrimental to the public health and safety and otherwise in the public interest.

Based on our conversation on March 24, 2014, during which you advised that the DLA has decided to pursue an alternate licensing option, that of a request for a "possession only" materials license, we have voided your application. This action is taken without prejudice to the resubmission of your request.
