Mr. Couture:

By letter dated March 24, 2014 (ADAMS Accession No. ML14085A257), Entergy Nuclear Operations, Inc. (the licensee) submitted for the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) amendment to revise the site emergency plan (SEP) for the permanently defueled condition. The proposed amendment would revise the on-shift staffing and Emergency Response Organization (ERO) staffing. The licensee has reviewed the proposed changes against the planning standards in 10 CFR 50.47(b) and requirements in 10 CFR 50, Appendix E and concludes that the standards and requirements will continue to be met.

Consistent with 10 CFR 50.90 an amendment to the license (including the technical specifications) must fully describe the changes requested, and following as far as applicable, the form prescribed for original applications. Section 50.34 of 10 CFR addresses the content of technical information required. This section stipulates that the submittal address the design and operating characteristics, unusual or novel design features, and principal safety considerations.

The NRC staff has reviewed your application and concluded that it does provide technical information in sufficient detail to enable the staff to proceed with its detailed technical review and make an independent assessment regarding the acceptability of the proposed amendment in terms of regulatory requirements and the protection of public health and safety and the environment. If additional information is needed for the staff to complete its technical review, you will be advised by separate correspondence.
