Dear Mr. Jameson:

This letter is our request to transfer the Sealed Source and Device Registration Certificate from Arizona to Georgia. Currently Honeywell devices are no longer manufactured or distributed in the State of Arizona. Manufacturing operations are still conducted in Waterford, Ireland and in North Vancouver, Canada. In the United States distribution of Honeywell devices is only from our facility in Duluth, Georgia.

To make Honeywell devices consistent with the policies of the US Nuclear Regulatory Commission we are requesting that the Georgia Department of Resources transfer the SS&D certificate for the Honeywell Model 4201 Thickness Gauge, from Arizona to Georgia. We have been distributing the Models 1201/2201 Series, 1202/2202 Series, 1203 Series, and 204 Series device since 1996, in the United States and World wide without any significant incidents that threatened the health and safety of personnel, property or the environment.

To assist you in the transfer I have included a complete file containing all documents submitted to both California and Arizona.
