This letter is in reference to the petition for rulemaking (PRM) that was submitted to the U.S Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) on December 20, 2013, as corrected on January 7, 2014 (the NRC's Agencywide Documents Access and Management System Accession Nos. ML14029A124, ML14029A169, and ML14029A154). The NRC staff has completed an acceptance review under § 2.802 of Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (10 CFR), "Petition for rulemaking," and your petition has been docketed. Your petition has been assigned Docket Number PRM-51-30.

The enclosed notice acknowledging receipt of the petition will be published in the *Federal Register*. The NRC is not instituting a public comment period for this PRM at this time.
