Dear Mr. Tran:

In order to continue the review of our request to renew Materials License 13-06009-01, I am providing the following information:

- 1) The Sr-90 ophthalmic source Model 67-850 SN: B450-12 was disposed of through Bionomics to Energy Solutions with a completion date of 9/26/13. Please remove it from the license.
- 2) We possess only one HDR unit, a Micro-Selectron Model 105.999, SN: 31417. The Nucletron Microselectron-HDR classic was returned to Nucletron subsequent to approval of our amendment request dated 12/30/2002. I was unable to locate documentation verifying the classic was returned to Nucletron. There were no leaking sources associated with the classic unit while it was under our license. The Model 105.999 was listed on our 7/15/03 license renewal request.
- 3) We continue to possess and store depleted uranium from a linear accelerator collimator and an Am-241 sealed source (Amersham Model AMC-24). We will dispose of them when a waste depository site able to take trans-uranium radionuclides becomes available.
