On August 4, 2014, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) will begin a License Renewal Inspection at your Byron Station. This inspection will be performed in accordance with NRC Inspection Procedure (IP) 71002.

The on-site portion of the inspection will take place as follow:

- Week 1: August 4 – 8, 2014
- Week 2: August 18 – 22, 2014

The lead inspector for this inspection is Caroline Tilton. We understand that our regulatory contact for this inspection is Mr. Gary Contrady of your organization. Experience has shown that these inspections are extremely resource intensive, both for the NRC inspectors and the applicant staff. In order to minimize the inspection impact on the site and to ensure a productive inspection for both parties, we would like to request the documents needed for the inspection. The lead inspector already has a copy of the original license renewal application. In order to ensure the inspection team is adequately prepared for the inspection, please provide a copy of any amendments to the application. This information should be made available via email to the lead inspector no later than July 21, 2014. The lead inspector will coordinate with your staff to determine what additional information the team will review, or need access to, during the onsite inspection. It is important that all documents provided are up to date and complete.
