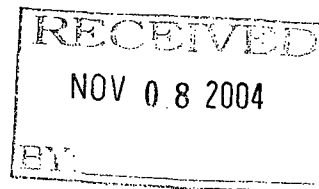


Dear Mr. Jameson:

The following information is provided in support of our letter dated September 7, 2004 seeking to replace the 3890 Steve Reynolds Blvd address with the 4350 International Boulevard address for all purposes (e.g., material use, records, communications, etc.) on licenses GA 1350-1, GA 1350-2 and on the Sealed Source and Device Registration Certificate, GA-1115-D-101-S. Accordingly, I can affirm the following information on behalf of Novoste Corporation.

- Novoste has vacated the 3890 Steve Reynolds Boulevard address and all radiological materials, personnel, equipment, records and lines of communication have been transferred to the 4350 International Boulevard ("temporary") address.
- A physical inventory has been performed and all licensed radiological materials have been accounted for at the 4350 International Boulevard address.
- A final survey has been performed which documents the absence of contamination at the 3890 Steve Reynolds Boulevard address and a copy is attached.
- The FDA has authorized use of the 4350 International Boulevard address, rather than the 3890 Steve Reynolds Boulevard address for manufacturing and distribution of radioactive Beta-Cath<sup>TM</sup> System components.
- ***No licensed radioactive material from past Novoste Corporation operations remains at 3890 Steve Reynolds Boulevard.***
