On April 18, 2014, the NRC Staff issued a supplement to its Final Safety Evaluation Report (SER) for Strata Energy, Inc.'s (Strata's) proposed Ross Project. The supplemental SER revises the Staff's analysis of the meteorological data provided in Strata's Technical Report and introduces a new preoperational license condition requiring Strata to provide additional meteorological data for the NRC's verification prior to commencement of operations.
