On behalf of the nuclear energy industry, the Nuclear Energy Institute (NEI)¹ is pleased to have the opportunity to submit the attached copy of NEI 06-11, "Managing Personnel Fatigue at Nuclear Power Reactor Sites", Revision 2, for NRC review and endorsement. The attached guidance reflects the culmination of our public interactions with NRC staff and positions advocated in our three previous rulemaking petitions. This revision of NEI 06-11 also incorporates the restructuring recommendations and tables provided by the NRC staff in the July 16, 2013 public meeting. These changes will provide additional clarity and usability.

We understand that the NRC is still considering the industry's proposed guidance with respect to the NRC staff preliminary proposed rule language regarding Sequestration (ref: ADAMS ML13016A375), which was submitted via NEI letter on July 2, 2013. The guidance has been included in Section 11.5 (Sequestration) of the attached guideline.
