1. On page 7, the Draft Strategic Plan states that there are approximately 18,900 licenses. According to the November 18, 2013 license report, the NRC had 2,857 licenses while Agreement States had 17,988 for a total of 20,845. The Virginia Department of Health's Office of Radiological Health (ORH) recommends using the 20,845 figure as that is a published listing of the number of U.S. licenses.
2. On Page 7 in the "Future Challenges" section, all the bullets should have semi-colons with an "and" in the second to last bullet.
3. ORH recommends including "safe disposal of radioactive materials" in the "Future Challenges" bulletized list.
4. On Page 10, the "Vision" sentence is missing a period at the end of the sentence.
5. On Page 12, ORH recommends including "Approval of Type B shipping containers" in section the 1.1-3.
6. On Page 13, ORH recommends adding 1.1-8 which would state: "Continued education of NRC and Agreement State staff to ensure the safe use of radioactive materials."

7. On Page 15, ORH recommends including “for nuclear facilities” after “including force-on-force exercises” in the first bullet.
8. On Page 135, ORH recommends adding item 2.1-7 which would state: “Continued education of NRC and Agreement State staff regarding security issues, measures and regulations.”
9. On Page 17, ORh recommends that a discussion of the Cumulative Effects on Regulations (CER) be included in “Regulatory Effectiveness” section.
10. On Page 17, ORH recommends including “for nuclear facilities” at the end of the second bulleted sentence.
11. On Page 28, ORH recommends that the NRC include an item in Appendix C regarding the Regulations program review that includes how CER will be included.
