Dear Mr. Lawyer,

This letter is a request to revise and update the letter sent to Mr. Oberg, Mail Control Number 117116, dated March 30, 1993.

The changes concern paragraph two which specifies who can conduct in house and field training of service technicians.

The original paragraph reads:

Employment by our company, as a service technician requires a minimum 2 years of engineering school. New technicians are trained, on our systems, under the supervision of our service manager, Paul Young (who is listed on our license). This combination of in-house and field training typically lasts for 1 year.

As Mr. Young is no longer employed by I2S LLC, I request that paragraph be updated to read:

Employment by our company, as a service technician requires a minimum 2 years of engineering school. New technicians are trained, on our systems, under the supervision of our Service Manager and Radiation Safety Officer, both of whom are listed on our license. This combination of in-house and field training typically lasts for 1 year.
