Eric,

This is a follow up to our phone conversation on Friday, June 5, regarding our Analyzer-5 SS&D amendment. I had asked if we could allow the operators of the analyzers to remove the source rod from the device and place it in the storage drum for routine maintenance of the belt idlers in the tunnel extensions of the analyzer. This would only apply to the manual drive configuration.

Because of the time schedule we are on, I would like to leave the amendment as it is currently, that is, requiring a licensed service person to perform this task, and let it proceed through concurrence, issuing the license as quickly as possible. We will address this issue in an amendment at a later date when we have more experience, data, and a proper set of procedures worked out to adequately protect the operator from radiation exposure.

Thank you for your assistance and I will be looking forward to hearing from you on the status of the application.
