

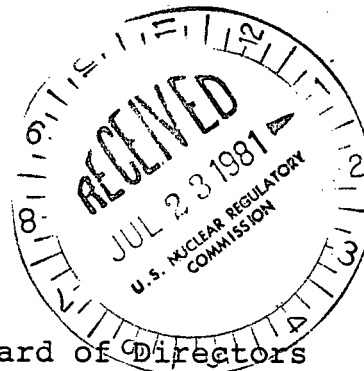

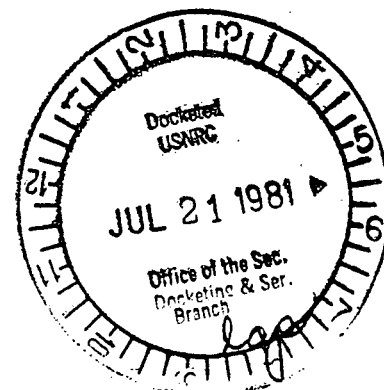

RESOLUTION 7860

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE
METROPOLITAN WATER DISTRICT OF SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA
CONCERNING SAN ONOFRE NUCLEAR GENERATING STATION

WHEREAS, as a major user of electrical energy, the Metropolitan Water District is acutely aware of the need to develop new power resources to meet the needs of California's expanding population and to reduce this country's dependence on foreign oil;

WHEREAS, Units 2 and 3 of the San Onofre Nuclear Generating Station have been completed and are now ready for operational licensing by the federal Nuclear Regulatory Commission;

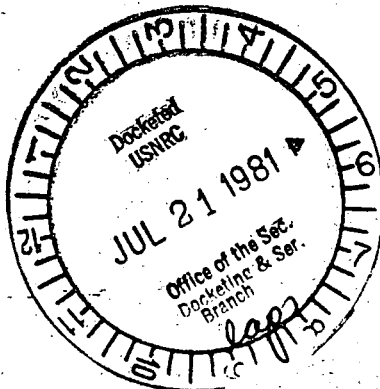
WHEREAS, by using ocean water rather than fresh water for cooling purposes, the San Onofre plant will help conserve California's precious water resources;


WHEREAS, Metropolitan has consistently supported nuclear power as a safe, economical, and environmentally sound alternative for the generation of electrical energy.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of The Metropolitan Water District of Southern California that this District does hereby urge the Nuclear Regulatory Commission to issue an operating license for Units 2 and 3 of the San Onofre Nuclear Generating Station as soon as possible.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Executive Secretary is hereby directed to file forthwith a certified copy of this resolution with the Nuclear Regulatory Commission Atomic Safety and Licensing Board.
