3. a continued commitment to conservation of our energy resources

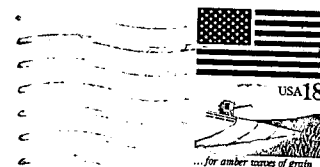

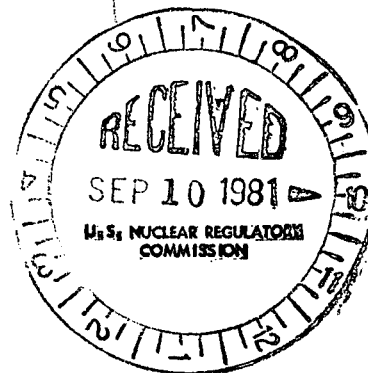
